Course Description D330/1

Start on A49 on the south side of Prees bypass, opposite "right turn sign" (going south), at the start of the central hatched area, 0.17m south of the bridge joint on the bypass bridge. Marked with Line. **Proceed** north along A49 to Prees Island (give way line at entrance to roundabout), **2.93m**. **Note, local regulation in force at this roundabout. No tri-bar use**. Encircle and proceed south along A49 to Battlefield Church Island, **17.0mls**. Encircle and proceed north along A49, past initial start point, **28.1mls**. Continue to **Finish** opposite the start of the entrance junction for Prees Heath Common, **30.0mls**

There will be no "pusher-off" at the start for this event.



IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL COMPETITORS

<u>Please note CTT regulations requiring a working front as well as rear light and the compulsory use of helmets for all competitors:</u>

In accordance with Regulation 14(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine **a working rear red light**, **either flashing or constant**, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

In accordance with Regulation 14(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine **a working front white light, either flashing or constant**, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users

In accordance with Regulation 15 - <u>All competitors</u> must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard.

There will be a separate start line official checking compliance with the regulations. Any competitor not in compliance will not be allowed to start.

AT NO TIME SHOULD RIDERS PERFORM U-TURNS IN THE ROAD

PLEASE KEEP YOUR HEAD UP AT ALL TIMES

Prees Heath Roundabout. Local District Regulations require riders to negotiate this RAB in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders must not use their tri-bars/extensions between the first bollard they pass on entering the island and the last bollard they pass on leaving it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified and may be reported for further disciplinary action.
