Courses and roads assessed. L135 A6 High Hesket - Stonybeck	Course local to: High Hesket (A6, between Carlisle and Penrith, approx. 5 miles south J42). 13.6 mile Hilly, Type B Course
Date of assessment/review: Approved 15 Jan 2020	Name of assessor: Lee Foster, Border City Wheelers.

### **Course description**

START: South end of layby on High Hesket A6 by-pass, just north of direction sign for Ling. Follow A6 south for approx. 6.8 miles passing through Plumpton to the Stonybeck roundabout. Encircle the roundabout, taking 6th exit to retrace along A6 northbound. Follow A6 north to finish adjacent to field gate opposite the start (13.6m).

### **Traffic flows**

Wide A roads with a roundabout at the southern end. Moderate and well within guidance notes for single carriageway courses.

### **Course event/history**

This is a Type A (Open) events course (2019), which is identical to the Type B course that was approved in March 2019. The latter risk assessment has been adapted here, essentially unchanged.

#### NOTES:

- 1. The use of a vehicle for the timekeeper(s) at start and finish is where appropriate and is only identified as an example for the action to be taken.
- 2. The small junctions or entrances to farms/facilities (garage, eatery, etc) that are not identified in this risk assessment have been considered, however are not considered significant to pose a risk and therefore have not been noted.
- 3. All rules of the road must be followed as to 'the Highway Code'.
- 4. This risk assessment shall be made available at the event signing on. By the riders signing on to event sheet they accept all hazards identified on this course and are aware that this is an open road event and that they have a duty of care and courtesy to other road users.
