Course description

START on the A59 Clitheroe to Gisburn road at top of Sawley Brow at a point in line with a metal gateway at the western end of a large lay-by on south side of road. Proceed south west along the A59 through first roundabout (4.45m) to turn at the second roundabout, junction with A671 (Clitheroe), (5.74m). Retrace along the A59 to finish at lamppost No 778 approximately 50 yards before the junction with local road to Chatburn. (10.00 MILES)

Traffic flows

Wide A roads with some dual carriageway sections. Out and back with riders retracing at A59 Clitheroe roundabout.

Course event/history

This is a Type A (Open) events course.

6		Riders continue on A59	Passing traffic and traffic at minor junctions.	LOW	No additional measures required
7	4.45 miles	Riders continue straight on at Sabden/Clitheroe roundabout	Roundabout with traffic from right and traffic emerging from Sabden to left.	MED	Organiser to place cycle event warning signs and position 2 marshals at both left and right junctions for safety and direction. Organiser to place a notice in start sheet to remind riders that they may need to give way to traffic from their right.
8	5.74 miles	Clitheroe roundabout	Riders encircle roundabout to retrace on A59. Riders need to give way to traffic from right from Clitheroe.	MED	Organiser to place cycle event warning signs and position 3 marshals for safety and to direct riders. Organiser to place a notice in start sheet to remind riders that they may need to give way to traffic from their right.
9		Riders continue straight on at Sabden/Clitheroe roundabout	Roundabout with traffic from right and traffic emerging from Clitheroe to left.	MED	Covered by mitigation measures for Item 7.

NOTES:

- 1. The use of a vehicle for the timekeeper(s) at start and finish is where appropriate and is only identified as an example for the action to be taken.
- 2. The small junctions or entrances to farms/facilities (garage, eatery, etc) that are not identified in this risk assessment have been considered, however are not considered significant to pose a risk and therefore have not been noted.
- 3. All rules of the road must be followed as to 'the Highway Code'.
- 4. This risk assessment shall be made available at the event signing on. By the riders signing on to event sheet they accept all hazards identified on this course and are aware that this is an open road event and that they have a duty of care and courtesy to other road users.
