5	En route - Road fairly narrow	Road narrow for the duration of the climb, just wide enough for cyclist and traffic to pass. Mostly good visibility for approaching traffic.	L	<b>Organiser</b> to ensure riders have been made aware of course prior to race. Signs on course warning traffic.	L
6	Steep ascent	Steep ascent - competitors may ride 'off line'	L	<b>Organiser</b> prominently display head up sign for traffic & ensure riders have been made aware of course prior to race.	L
7	Finish line (1 mile) at summit GR SD257878	Riders stopping and marshals on verge. Plenty of room off road just near finish line.	L	No additional measures required.	L
8	Riders returning down course.	Potential conflict with competitors and/or traffic on course.	L	<b>Organiser</b> to warn riders at signing on to take care on descent and to avoid impeding	L
