3 Start area	Competitors proceed to start at a point directly opposite south end of the parking layby.	L	<b>Organiser</b> to ensure cycle event warning triangle(s) placed before start and timekeeper to warn riders not to encroach onto carriageway before starting.	L
4 Start on A6	Competitor/holder up falling.	L	No additional measures required.	L
5 Riders proceed south on A6 to Stoneybeck roundabout	Junctions onto A6 from minor roads. All have good visibility for emerging traffic and carry only light traffic.	L	No additional measures required.	L
6 Stoneybeck roundabout	Riders take third exit from Stoneybeck roundabout to join link road to M6 Junction 41.	<b>M</b>	<b>Organiser</b> to place cycle event warning signs at all approaches to the roundabout. 2 marshals required for direction and safety.	L
7 M6 Junction 41 roundabout	Riders encircle the roundabout and take 5th exit to rejoin link road to Stonebeck roundabout.	<b>M</b>	<b>Organiser</b> to place cycle event warning signs at all approaches to the roundabout. 2 marshals required for direction and safety.	L
8 Stoneybeck roundabout	Riders take 2 <sup>nd</sup> exit from Stoneybeck roundabout to join A6 north	L	<b>Organiser</b> to place cycle event warning signs at all approaches to the roundabout. 2 marshals required for direction and safety.	L

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9 Riders proceed north on A6 to finish opposite the start, 1/2 mile south of M6 junction 42	Junctions onto A6 from minor roads. All have good visibility for emerging traffic and carry only light traffic.	L	No additional measures required.	L
10 Finish area.		L	<b>Organiser</b> to place cycle event warning signs before the finish to alert both north and south-bound traffic.	L
9 Return to HQ.	Riders disperse to their vehicles on Greenhollows forecourt and Gaitsgill road.	L	No additional measures required.	L
