Event Headquarters

Registration will be held at the event headquarters: The Ellesmere Centre, Ley Road, Stetchworth, Newmarket, Suffolk, CB8 9TS (<u>http://ellesmerecentre.org.uk/</u>). Registration will be open from 1130.

The event HQ is approximately a three-mile ride from the course start. There are ample quiet roads near the event HQ for warming-up.

Parking will be available at the event HQ. If the car park is full, please use the rough grass (and not the verge) outside.

Stetchworth is a quiet friendly village. Please help to preserve it by parking considerately and refraining from littering, public nudity and urinating. Any competitor seen doing these may be disqualified. Showers, changing rooms and toilets are available at the event HQ. Light refreshments will be available after the event.

Please do not wear cleated shoes in the village hall.

Please do not park in the start lay-by or near the finish area.

Rider Information

Course description

The course is the E33/25b (often labelled E33/25¹). The start is half way along lay-by (marked Police only) on the A1303, situated 650 yards south-west of the Stetchworth roundabout.

From the start, proceed on the A1303 towards Cambridge, continuing to Dunsley Corner (5.18m) where you should take a left to follow lane to Six Mile Bottom (8.83m) where you take left turn at a cross-road and join the A1304 in the direction of Newmarket. Continue along the A1304 until the Stetchworth roundabout (12.39m) where you take the first left to rejoin the A1303, to finish first circuit at the start point (12.76m).

Proceed onto second circuit via A1303 to Dunsley Corner (17.94m), lane to Six Mile Bottom (21.59m) A1304 towards Newmarket to finish just before 'White Direction Board' which is 300 yards south of Stetchworth roundabout (25.00m).

After finishing continue to the Stetchworth roundabout and take a right turn to head back to the event HQ.

Drafting

"Competitors must ride entirely alone and unassisted, and not ride in company or take shelter from the other riders or vehicles. A competitor overtaking another must pass without receiving or giving shelter. The onus of avoiding company riding shall be upon the rider overtaken." Cycling Time Trials Regulation No. 18.

Your Safety

The course runs on public roads which may be busy with traffic. All riders are expected to obey the highway code.

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and Cambridge University Cycling Club strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

In order to be eligible for BUCS points or medals you must wear a helmet and use a rear light.

U-turns are not permitted within sight of the start and finish points, nor on the course. Offenders are liable for disqualification.

There are good, quiet roads for warming up near the sign on area. **Do not warm up on the course once the event is in progress.**

¹ The E33/25a uses the same course, but has the start and finish further along the A1303 (near Bottisham).

Please note as you head to the start you are riding on the course (the section from the Stetchworth roundabout to the lay-by) – please take extra care and do not impede riders who are racing.

The course is, for the most part, well-surfaced with no substantial potholes.

Please keep your head up at all times. Marshalls will be stationed at turning points, but it is the responsibility of riders to know the course.

Riders should take care not to branch left onto the A14 when the A1303 crosses it. Keep right and follow the A1303 (over a FURTHER bridge), and THEN down the hill (keeping on the A1303).

After turning left at Dunsley Corner (exiting the A1303), riders should be aware of a dangerous joint in the road surface on the bridge over the A14

When turning left onto the A1304, riders do not have right of way. Visibility is poor at this junction (a cross-roads) – and riders should take care.

At the Stetchworth roundabout rider must give way to traffic coming from their right and give clear signals as to their intended route.

There should be no stopping at the finish, riders *must* carry on to the Stetchworth roundabout and take a right turn to head back to the HQ. Riders must not hassle or approach the timekeepers for their time.
