Youth Time Trial Championship (South DC District Heat)

The Youth Championships (formally the GHS Championships) is for those under 17 years of age on 31st August in the year of the Competition. This Championship is unique in that competitors need not be members of affiliated clubs as they can ride in the name of their school. Regional competitions take place with winners going forward to the National event.

There are district heats across the country and the fastest three boys, three girls, fastest team of three and the fastest boy and girl in each age category qualify for the National final in September.

Compulsory Notices

All riders must wear a hard-shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.



All riders to have a working rear light, either flashing or constant, fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machines in use.



No dark glasses or visors to be worn due to tree lined section of the course



Parental consent form must be signed. No ride if this is not completed

Advisory Notices

- Cover brakes through Funtington and East Ashling due to possibility of pedestrian and car movements in the village.
- A working front light is also recommended to increase visibility.

Course Description

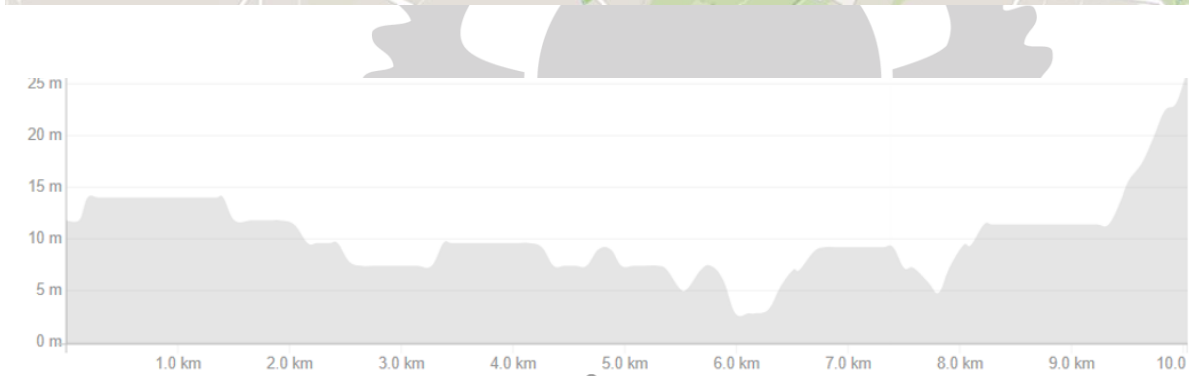
START in Common Road at Churchers Corner opposite an abandoned post for a GPO Pillar box in a Lay-by, east of crossroads with B2147 (SU 775084).

PROCEED East on Common Road to Funtington to join B2146. Continue B2146/B2178 via Funtington and East Ashling.

Turn left onto Hunters Race (4.5m/7.2km) then **take next sharp** left (4.8m/7.7km) onto West Stoke Road.

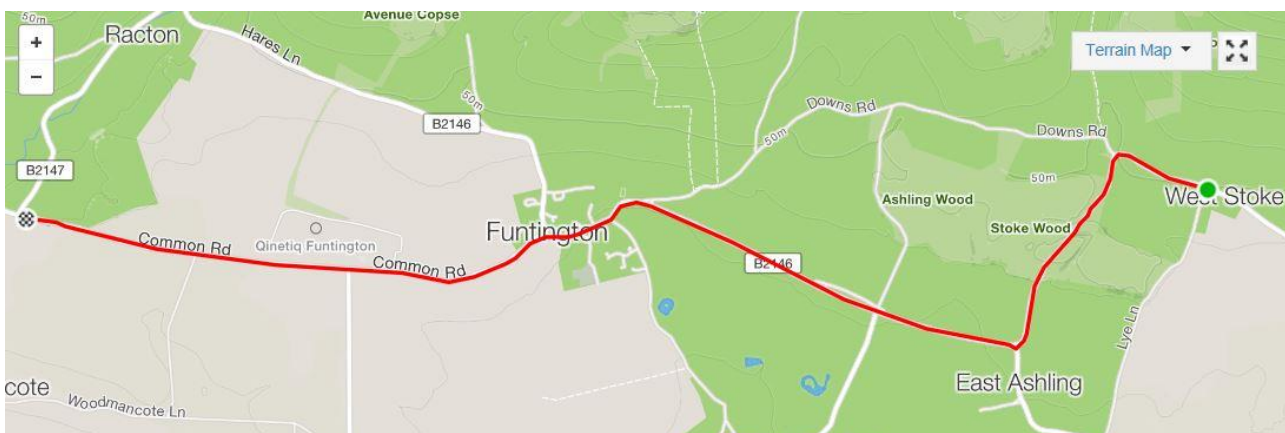
Proceed to junction then turn left (5.85m/9.4 km) heading west onto Downs Road towards West Stoke.

FINISH in West Stoke opposite TP621 outside of 1 Lye Court Cottage and 15 Yards before Lye Lane and West Stoke Village Hall. (6.2m/10k) (SU 829085)



Route from HQ to Start

From West Stoke Village hall go left on Downs Road past St. Andrew's Church and follow the road round to the left. Continue to T junction. Turn Right onto B2146, continue through Funtington to join Common Road until you reach Churchers corner. Total distance 3.85 miles (6.2 km).



Note: allow at least 20 minutes to get to the start. Use this ride as part of your warm up.
