
START (OS 166: TL282 115) at LP 116 in Old Coach Road (old A414) at Cole Green. Proceed east through Birch Green and Staines Green to T-Junction at outskirts of Hertingfordbury, where:-.

Turn Left and immediately turn left again onto A414 dual carriageway.

Continue west to the RAB junction A414 / B195 where:-

Turn left to complete circuit. Complete 2 more circuits to:-

FINISH in Old Coach Lane, at start point at end of 3rd lap.



Regulation 15. Protective Helmets

All competitors under the age of 18 years and / or Juniors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard / soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078. It is the responsibility of the rider (or parent or guardian if the rider is under 18 years of age) to:

- a) Select a Helmet that offers protection against head injury and does not restrict the rider's vision or hearing.
- b) Ensure that the helmet is properly fitted, is undamaged and in good condition.

Local Regulations.

- No.1. No U turns should be made in sight of the start or finish areas while riding on the public highway.
- No.3. No cars other than that of the timekeeper(s) and other event officials are to be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish points.
 - NO FOLLOWING CARS, offenders are liable to disqualification.
 - Absolutely no parking on any part of the course, at any time.
 - Please collect race numbers in person at the H.Q. and sign the required form. Return to HQ after your ride and 'SIGN OUT'.
