Each year we use this event to raise much-needed funds for a charity which is close to our hearts. This year we have chosen to support the Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance, which effectively delivers the equivalent of an A&E department to a seriously injured person and can transport them to the best hospital to treat their injuries in as little as 8 minutes. We felt that, as cyclists who often ride on busy roads, any of us might one day need the services of the ambucopter and that this event gives us a chance to give back and support the charity.

Your entry fee isn't the only way you can support the Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance at the Charity 10. We will also be selling raffle tickets and homemade post-ride cakes!

I would like to take this opportunity to ask that you do not park in front of the Event HQ and instead use the car park on Grantham Road. We would like to continue to use St Botoloph's Church Hall for future events, for this reason we need to make sure we don't upset the local residents!

About Our Chosen Charity

The Lincs & Notts Air Ambulance is a dedicated Helicopter Emergency Medical Service. We can reach any point in the two counties in less than 20 minutes and on average can transfer a patient to hospital within 8 minutes. Each mission costs approx £2,500 and we fly an average of 3 missions per day, 365 days of the year. Each year we need to raise £2.5m to keep flying and saving lives.

Since our Charity began, over 23 years ago, we have undertaken more than 18,600 lifethreatening missions, delivering specialist medical attention to the people of Lincs & Notts in their greatest hour of need. Traveling at speeds sometimes in excess of 200mph, our skilled team of pilots, doctors and paramedics effectively bring the equivalent of an A&E department to the scene of an incident and can transport a patient to a specialist unit or major hospital in a fraction of the time taken by road ambulance.

We are based at RAF Waddington, south of Lincoln. This base is unaffected by road congestion, country roads, heavy vehicles or road works. Our Helicopter, affectionately known as our 'Ambucopter', is fully equipped for almost any medical emergency. It is usually staffed by a pilot, two paramedics and a doctor.

Every year we are called upon for approximately 1,000 missions. Each year the generous people of Lincolnshire and Nottinghamshire help us raise the money to do this! Please continue to spread the word, organise fundraisers, play our lottery, volunteer your time and donate to our 11 charity shops across the counties. Together we can keep this vital lifesaving service operating for many years to come.


Event Information

Event HQ

The Event HQ for this event will be St Botolph's Church Hall, Grantham Road, Sleaford, which will be open from 1pm.

Directions: From the A15/A153 roundabout take exit to Sleaford. HQ is approximately 1 mile on the left.


Parking is available 200 yards away at £2 per day. There is no parking outside the Event HQ due to issues with local residents.



Course Details

To get to the start from Event HQ go right towards Grantham. Take the first exit at Quarrington roundabout onto the A15. The start is approximately half a mile along on the left.

C10/10: Start on A15 Sleaford Bypass 0.25 miles South of Quarrington Roundabout (A15/A153/B1517) near field entrance with large tarmac entrance both sides of A15. Proceed South on A15 through Osbournby to Roundabout (A15/A52). Encircle Roundabout and retrace along A15 to Finish approximately 80 yards short of lay-by sign (approximately 1 mile going south) and 0.32 miles short of the Start.

Rules and Regulations

Numbers

These will be issued when signing on and must be returned when signing back in (Reg. 17b).

The number shall be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in his/her normal riding position.

Restrictions

There must be no warming up on the course once the event is in progress.

U turns are not permitted in the vicinity of the Start and Finish areas.

No head/earphones are permitted, except for hearing aids (Reg. 19).

Sleeveless tops are not permitted (Reg. 16).

Please call your number out upon completing your ride.

Advice to Riders

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell helmet that meets a recognized standard.

All competitors under the age of 18 years and/or Juniors must wear a properly affixed helmet, as per Regulation 15.

CTT recommend that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
