IN THE INTEREST OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

Course Details: U21/10:

Start adjacent to farm gate on unclassified road (Cross Lane) prior to crossroad east of junction with A38. After start LEFT turn (CARE) onto A38.then proceed south on A38 to turn at East Brent RAB (5miles). Return north on A38. Finish on A38 just short of the cross roads and start. No U-turns within sight of the Start and Finish Timekeepers.

Please Call Number Loud and Clear When Finishing

Headquarters:

Biddisham Village Hall, Badgworth, Axbridge, BS26 2RE (situated on the A38 approximately half-way along the course)

Facilities:

The HQ will be open from 5:30 pm. Signing on and number collection will be at the HQ.

Parking:

There is a small car park at the race HQ. If this is full, there is additional parking in a small layby 250 metres towards East Brent and a larger layby 900 metres towards Axbridge. Riders and officials are NOT to use the entrance to the industrial estate 130 metres east of the hall for parking, as we have had issues with cars blocking lorry access to the site.

Important Notes for Riders and Officials:-

- In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trail and the event promotors strongly advise that riders wear a Hard Shell Helmet that meets approved international safety standards.
- Numbers will be at the HQ and can be exchanged for a drink at the end.
- Please be aware of the new CTT Regulation 17(b). All competitors in open (Type A) events will be required to return to the event HQ, hand in their number(s) and SIGN OUT. A competitor MUST sign out him/herself. It is not permissible for another person to sign out on behalf of the competitor. Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.
- Riders are to ensure that they read the course risk assessment, including the on-the-day risk assessment, prior to starting the event which will be next to the numbers at the HQ.
- No U-Turns within sight of the Start and Finish Timekeepers or warming up after the start.
- Riders waiting to start must keep well to the left and in single file.
- The start area, including the field gate, is NOT to be used as a toilet.
- It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine clearly visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
- 2-up teams should have clothing of similar design & colours.
