A counting event for the n&dca best all rounder competition

Course description

- START to the West of Pegswood on Dark Lane at the speed de-restriction sign at gap in hedge.
- Proceed to Whorral Bank Roundabout (R/A) and take first exit onto A197 in direction of Ashington.
- Continue over R/A to outskirts of Ashington, through the pedestrian crossing (riders see safety notes) and take left onto A1068 to continue north over Linton and Ellington R/A's.
- At Widdrington South R/A bear right in the direction of Amble, then straight on at Widdrington North R/A along A1068 until left turn onto B1330 via Red Row, South Broomhill and Broomhill (Be aware of traffic calming priorities).
- Take left turn onto B6345 via Acklington until marshalled left turn onto the un-classified road via Stobswood, Widdrington Station and take double right turn onto B1337 to Ulgham.
- For first three laps continue through Ulgham on B1337, via Longhirst (traffic calming priorities) to return to Whorral Bank roundabout and start of next lap.
- On the last, 4th lap, FINISH approximately ½ miles South West of Ulgham at the south end of bridge over old opencast road (this is approx. 150 metres past turning on right to Tritlington and 1 mile north of Longhirst).

Safety notes

- Vehicles of competitors/ officials/ marshals/ helpers to be parked safely and without hindrance to other road users.

Riders:

- On approach to Ashington there is a pedestrian crossing. This will be marshalled in the hope that it will not be activated during your passing. But if light is Red, you MUST stop as a legal requirement.
- There are 6 occasions on the course where narrow road traffic calming is in place. 2 are priority to riders and 4 have priority to oncoming traffic. Take note of any warning notices and Marshals at these points.
- On occasions where road narrows and/or cars are parked, riders to take extra care.
- No U Turns to be made in the vicinity of the timekeepers.
- No dismounting in the finish area. Remember this is a lapped event and competitors may still be racing past finish area.

PLEASE NOTE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ABOVE:

- Any rider observed crossing the pedestrian crossing in Ashington while the Red Light is activated will be disqualified.
- Any other dangerous riding observed, including not yielding to oncoming traffic when required to do so by traffic calming measures will result in disqualification.

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

All competitors under the age of 18 years and/or Juniors must wear a properly affixed helmet that conforms to recognised standards.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Note change of HQ from last year – Pegswood, this year.

Note there are a number of roundabouts not marshalled and only have a direction sign.

Note the road surface in places is poor, in particular through Acklington – TAKE CARE.

One rider, one prize, except team prizes and road bike prize.

Prizes will be awarded in the priority order shown.

These prizes open to all riders including the Non-N&DCA affiliated riders.

Fastest rider affiliated to the Northumberland & Durham Cycling Association wins the N&DCA 100 mile championship, and the Gateshead Cycling Club Memorial Trophy (presented at the N&DCA awards night in January).

Fastest veteran on standard who is affiliated to the Northumberland & Durham Cycling Association wins the N&DCA Jack Adams Memorial Trophy (also presented at the N&DCA awards night).

Any riders whose club is not affiliated to the N&DCA, or are not individually affiliated before the day of the race will not be eligible for the championship or the trophies.

A club may affiliate if it is registered with the North East or Teesside CTT Districts. An individual may affiliate (if their club has not, or cannot) provided they reside within the North East or Teesside CTT Districts.

To affiliate a club, a payment of £30 is required to be sent to the N&DCA treasurer. For an individual affiliation a payment of £10 is required. Please contact Don Speight directly if more information is required.

Further Information and Notes

Each rider to sign the sign-on sheet when collecting number and sign-off when returning number also recording time when signing-off. CTT Regulations state that all competitors MUST sign off failure to do this will result in a DNF.

The HQ will be open for signing on from 6.15am. After sign on, the HQ may be locked, and if so will re-open at approx. 11.15am. If you DNF before this time, please leave your number with a course marshal.

Please do not use any kind of turbo trainer or rollers to warm up in Pegswood. The longevity of using the venue as an HQ of the event requires the goodwill of local residents. If you need to use these items, please sign on then find suitable parking outside the village.

There will be a prize presentation, however this is likely to be at 1.00pm at the earliest, once all riders have finished and had time to arrive at the HQ.

There is very limited parking at the HQ, but you should be able to find space in the streets nearby, but please respect residential spaces and access. Also – there is a layby for parking just north of Whorral Bank R/A, close to the start.

Number Placement

To assist the timekeepers at the finish line can you please ensure that your number is correctly placed and visible from the rear in line with CTT regulations noted below. If your number is too high, the timekeepers will not be able to see it. It should be correctly placed and visible at all times to ensure that the timekeepers correctly record your number of laps, and so that the marshals are aware of your position on the course.

“The number shall be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in his normal riding position. Position number as shown:



Please be aware of the following key wording from the CTT rules and regulations which are relevant to this event:

Competitors Clothing

Competitors must be clothed from the neck to at least mid-thigh. Sleeves shall be at least mid upper arm length.

No competitor may carry advertising or the name of a commercial business on his race clothing except where he is a member of a club or team that has paid the advertising fee, he may carry advertising, but must not compete in clothing of a trade team that is/has been registered with the UCI unless he is a member of that team.

Paced & Company Riding

Competitors must ride entirely alone and unassisted and not ride in company or take shelter (commonly known as drafting) from other riders or vehicles. A competitor overtaking another must pass without receiving or giving shelter. The onus of avoiding company riding shall be upon the rider overtaken.

This is not an exhaustive list of rules and riders are advised to be familiar with the CTT rules and regulation found on the CTT website.
