Course Details – Q10.24

Grain – Fenn Corner RAB – Grain

Start on A.228 west of Grain village 14 metres north of the lamppost GFY26 on the Strood bound carriageway, by a minor access road to the National Grid site, where the continuous white road edge line starts. Proceed west on A228 to turn at Fenn Corner roundabout (5.07 miles). (M) Retrace on A.228 to finish directly opposite the lamppost GFY19 (situated on Strood bound carriageway) (10 miles).

Event Headquarters

Lower Stoke Community Centre, Lower Stoke, Rochester, Kent. ME3 9RE – open from 2.pm.

Signing on sheet and the numbers will be inside the event HQ, exchange your number for a cuppa when you have finished and worked up an appetite. **Please remember to sign off after you have finished otherwise you will be recorded as DNF.**

Keep noise to a minimum in the car park so as not to disturb local residents and remember to remove racing shoes before entering the village hall. Rider Feedback Forms will be available at the signing on point, these forms can be used by riders and/or marshals with comments and suggestions to improve safety of the course.

Do not perform 'U' turns at the start and finish areas.

Do not use the start area as a public toilet, offenders risk disqualification, toilet facilities will be found at the HQ

Riders should be aware of Regulation 16 which states 'the number should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in the normal riding position'.
