An Easter heatwave! Dry, sunny and very warm with just that gusting breeze making the return journey a bit slower. Still that didn't stop a lot of riders from improving with 40 of the 99 finishers ending up with a new PB and 15 disqualifying themselves from next year's event having beaten 56:00.

Many congratulations to the Lincoln Wheelers trio of trike riders, Ian Wright, Andy Newham and Dave Mason on their new 25 miles Trike Team Competition Record. Their time of 2:54:17 beat the old record set in 1992 by 5 minutes and 19 seconds. Lincoln Wheelers now hold the 15, 25 and 30 Trike Team records and we wish them more success as they set about re-writing the record books.

Because of the ruling that riders who had previously beaten 56:00 before the event could not count for the prizes the actual fastest lady is not the winner of the Fastest Ladies award but I'm sure Amy Pritchard will be pleased to have improved her time once again. Our congratulations to you all and especially to the prize winners. Martin Cane's excellent 52:36 was an improvement of over 4 minutes. Second fastest Neil Crowther (53:08) and third fastest Sam Hughes (53:27) both had substantial improvements making their long journeys to the E2 worthwhile. Folkestone Velo Club were well pleased with their Team win. Helen Reynolds with her 58:04 took the Ladies' first place award with Grazyna Monaghan second with 1:00:19 while Dave Mason on his trike produced an impressive improvement of 10:37 to head that prize list.

The Shaftesbury have now been promoting the MM 25 for 52 years, always with the intention of giving up-and-coming riders the chance to ride on the faster courses. The limit has got faster over the years and this year we lowered the limit to 56:00. Despite that entries were still well short of the 150 field limit but that could well be due to the event coinciding with Easter Saturday. As most of you will know the E2 25 course cannot be used during the summer months of June, July and August and May is already full of established events so we had no alternative to the April date which is where we will probably be next year.

For those of you still outside the 56 limit look out for our event next year, we'd be delighted to receive your entry.
