Course RS/22 revised

GR 161 197198 (S) 192201 (F)

Revised route due to closure of A479 Tretower-Talgarth road. Start in pull-in (AA box no. 161) approx 25 yds east of and opposite Nantyffin Cider Mill Inn and east of A479 junction. Proceed on A40 to climb hill to Bwlch (3.5 miles), continue on A40 via Llansantffraed, Scethrog, Llanhamlach to Brecon East roundabout (10.5 miles). Encircle roundabout taking 4th exit to retrace on A40 via Llanhamlach, Scethrog, Llansantfraed to climb to Bwlch (18.2 miles). Descend hill (CARE on RH hairpin) to continue descending to take SHARP left (advers camber) to continue on A40 to FINISH at mark by field entrance and opposite 'Glenusk Estate' entrance (21.6 miles approx)

After you finish, continue along A40 for 2 miles into Crickhowell, turn Right (New Road) then first right into Crickhowell School Complex

The revised course is straightforward as it is now entirely on A40. The climb from the start to Bwlch (3.5 miles) negotiates a hairpin bend so take care. The Brecon East roundabout can be busy so PLEASE TAKE CARE. Road bikes are OK on this course Allow about 10 minutes to ride to the Start

All riders are asked to comply with the following requests.

- ✓ No warming up on the course once the event has started
- ✓ No U Turns within sight of start/finish TK
- ✓ No turbo training within 100 yards of dwellings
- ✓ Urinating in public is not tolerated: if you must go, use the HQ or be discreet!
- ✓ If you use a Nopinz type pocket on a skin suit please ensure your number is clearly visible. Pins are available for standard attachment
- ✓ Do call your number to the finishing timekeeper.
- ✓ IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear protective helmets.
- ✓ It is further recommended that a working rear light either flashing or constant is fitted to your machine in a position visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use
- ✓ This event is subject to Dope Control
- ✓ Remember to sign back in at the end or you will be DNF Awards
