That roundabout will feature once again so we'll be sending a similar message to the Sunday riders too; apologies to those of you who have to read it twice!

Our timekeepers this evening are Alf Williams [Port Talbot Wheelers] and Norman James [Ogmore Valley Wheelers], two great supporters of time trialling in the South Wales district and we thank them for their services tonight.

You can look forward to a free drink back at the HQ after your ride, plus a variety of snacks. With such a small field our prizegiving options are going to be limited but we'll come up with something on the night! In any case, the post-race formalities won't take long so please stick around if your schedule permits and with a bit of luck we'll all be home before dark.

## GETTING TO THE START

This couldn't be easier. As you emerge from the HQ building, just turn left and proceed along the industrial estate's service road for about 200 metres and the start line is on the right hand side of the road.

## THE R10/22A COURSE

We'll have marshals stationed at the turning point but please remember that they're there for guidance only and have no authority to control traffic. The R10/22a is a simple out-and-back course but several roads converge at the turning point.

- START on Vale of Neath Supplier Estate service road opposite lamp post number 18.
- Proceed eastwards along service road to Resolven Roundabout. [0.458 miles]
  - Safety Notice – Do not cross the centre line of the road on right hand bend.
- Take first exit [left] along A465 dual carriageway westbound to first exit left. [4.862 miles]
- Continue up the loop to Tonna Roundabout where take first exit to Aberdulais Interchange. Take fourth exit down slip road to re-join A465 dual carriageway. [5.505 miles]

- Proceed eastbound to Resolven Roundabout where take first exit left to FINISH at access road to Canal Car Park on cross-valley link road. [10.006 miles]
- NG Coordinates:
  - Start – 282450 East 202250 North
  - Turn roundabout – 277000 East 199000 North
  - Finish – 282670 East 203100 North

## DISTRICT RULES

All riders are asked to comply with the following.

- Please call your number to the finishing timekeeper otherwise your time may not be recorded.
- Please keep your head up, be aware of your surroundings and HAVE A SAFE RIDE.
- In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear protective helmets. It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
- This event may be subject to doping control. It's YOUR responsibility to check.
- Sign in AND sign out; technically you haven't finished the event until you've signed out.
- Please don't pass the start time keeper or warm up on the course.
- Don't use a turbo trainer within 100m of residential areas.
- Failure to follow these rules will result in a disqualification and referral to the South Wales DC for further disciplinary action.

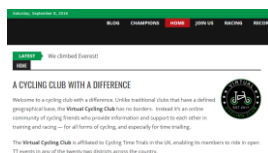
