Numbers and the **signing-on sheet** are held at the Race HQ. You **must sign-on** before you start - and read the **briefing notes**.

**Headquarters:
Lea Valley CC Race HQ
North Hall Road, Ugley, Essex CM22 6JD**

Turn off the B1383 at the Chequers PH and follow the road round passing underneath the M11 to the T-junction at the end. Turn left and the Race HQ is on right 50 yards along.

The best place to park is along North Hall Road or under the motorway bridge. Parking is not allowed in Widdington Lane and on the B1383 between Stansted Mountfitchet and Newport.

After the event don't forget to come back to the race HQ to return your number and get a cup of tea and a bacon butty.

Course E1/25b

START (O/S 513297) at 7th kerb joint from northern end of lay-by south of 34th milestone on the B1383 (just south of Quendon). Proceed north through Quendon, Newport, Littlebury and Great Chesterford to Stump Cross Roundabout (9.83m) (Marshal). Turn left at 1st exit onto A1301 to cross straight over next two roundabouts (passing under the A11 flyover) to the Hinxton Hall roundabout. Straight on here to Sawston roundabout at the junction with the A505. Turn at Sawston roundabout (12.25m) (Marshal & Checker) to retrace, passing under the A11 to Stump Cross roundabout. Turn right (Marshal), 2nd exit, on to B1383 and retrace along course to FINISH at the water gully at centre of green just north of the Chequers PH. (O/S 512289)
