Encircle R/A and retrace to Stoke Ferry R/A (M) where take 3 rd exit to continue along A134 to Wereham R/A where straight over to <u>FINISH</u> opposite gateway approx. ¹ / ₄ mile short of junction with A1122.

LOCAL REGULATIONS

U-TURNS Are not permitted on courses and roads adjacent to start and finish areas, whilst the event is in progress. NOTE a U-turn is defined as a 180° turn completed within the carriageway width whilst astride the machine.

NO warming up on course after the start of the event.

Failure to comply with these regulations may lead to disqualification from the event and further action by the district committee.

CYCLE HELMETS IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

All competitors under the age of 18 must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised standard such as SNELL B95, ANZI Z90.4, AUS/NZS, DIN 35/954, CPSC or

EN1078. It is the responsibility of the rider (or parent or guardian if rider is under 18 years) to:

(a) Select a helmet that offers protection against head injury and does not restrict the riders vision or hearing

(b) Ensure that the helmet is properly fitted, is undamaged and is in a good condition.

The East District Committee recommends that competitors should fit a rear L.E.D. light to enhance visibility to other road users.

Observers will be on the course. Please ride the event with the safety of yourself and other road users in mind. Thank you. Ming.
