Encircle roundabout taking 5th exit to retrace along B4265 to Gileston Cross Roads (8.366 miles) to continue on B4265 to FINISH at point 8 yards beyond '50' road sign, at field entrance on left (10.006 miles) and 591 yards before reaching Start point.

<b>NOTE TO PROMOTING SECRETARY:</b> After completion by the promoter this form must be lodged with each appropriate Chief Officer of Police <b>within whose area any</b> <b>portion of the route traverses</b> , not less than 28 days before the date of the event. However Cycling Time Trials' regulations provide that a copy of the form should be sent to the secretary of each district council in whose area the event passes to arrive not less than <b>42 days</b> before the date of the event. It is recommended that the Notice should be sent to the Chief Officer of Police at this time rather than immediately prior to the expiry of the statutory 28 days.
