### **Course Description**

## Longwick Circuit Course (HCC178c) Description:

Start on the unnamed road between Stanbridge Road and the A4129 at a point 36\* yards east of the minor road to Aston Sandford and opposite a field gate. Continue to the junction with the A4129 where turn left (M1) (Check). Continue southeast on A4129 through Longwick to the roundabout at the junction with the B4009 at the Sportsman's Garage. Take the first exit (M2) onto the B4009 and proceed to the second turning on the left. Turn left (M3) and go through Ford to the Haddenham-Aylesbury crossroads. Turn left (M4) (Check) to the first junction at Haddenham. Turn left (M5) for 0.22 mile to a point 30 yards before telegraph pole no. 05 and 0.02 miles before the entrance to the garden centre where finish.

# Marshals referred to in this course description (M1, M2) etc may be provided solely to indicate the course direction. They have no role whatsoever in the risk assessment itself.

\* Measured from the centre of the side road. From eastern kerb to start = 25 yards

#### Notes

START:

On left, just after the minor road to Aston Sandford Church (HP17 8JB) (opposite a gate. There is a verge where a car can be parked.

Riders could queue in the minor road and wait to be called to the start so there is only one rider at a time on the 'start' road. (This system works well on the C10/4 course in Lincs)

### FINISH:

On Stanbridge Road. It is 10 miles to the new houses (Mead Furlong/Fairfield Close). The next place to park a car is on the verge between the end of the houses and the entrance to the garden centre (Haddenham Garden Centre, 121 Stanbridge Road, HP17 8HN).
