It was especially pleasing to see the men's course record improved twice in the space of a couple of minutes, having been frozen at 50:58 for more than a decade. First there was **Ben JONES** (Port Talbot Wheelers CC) posting a 49:34 to hack a massive 84 seconds off the previous best, then along came **Chris Gibbard** (Bynea Cycling Club) with his 48:42 to lower the record by a further 52 seconds. Congrats once again to both riders. In the women's event the hour-mark was beaten by **Emma WYATT** (Hereford & District Wheelers CC) who claimed the win by a near four-minute margin and came within a minute of the course record.
