To all who entered, especially the 86 who rode.

The weather was fine and dry, and warm in the sunshine. Met Office recording stations at Hereford and at Filton showed a light wind that was generally Southerly but variable in direction. Some riders found it a little blustery. As usual on a Saturday afternoon, traffic levels were fairly light.

Out of 62 finishers with an LTS only 11 improved it, so conditions don't seem to have been particularly favourable.

Nevertheless there were some outstanding performances, in particular Ian and Rachel improving the tandem course record by nearly 20 minutes, and Angela improving the women's course record my more that 2 minutes. Angela's performance was particularly impressive when adjusted for age and gender, since her Vets Handicap Results was 1:30:30, which is 1 second quicker than Marcin Bialoblocki's national 50 mile record on E2/50 (set in 2018), and 6:30 quicker than the men's podium in this event, who were separated by only 15 seconds from each other.

Both LTS Improvement prizes were taken by competitors in the women's event: Maria Powell improved by nearly 10 minutes, and Neive Richardson by nearly 9 minutes.
