

Bolsover District Cycling Club HARDWICK HALL HILL CLIMB – with great thanks to our hosts National Trust Hardwick Hall



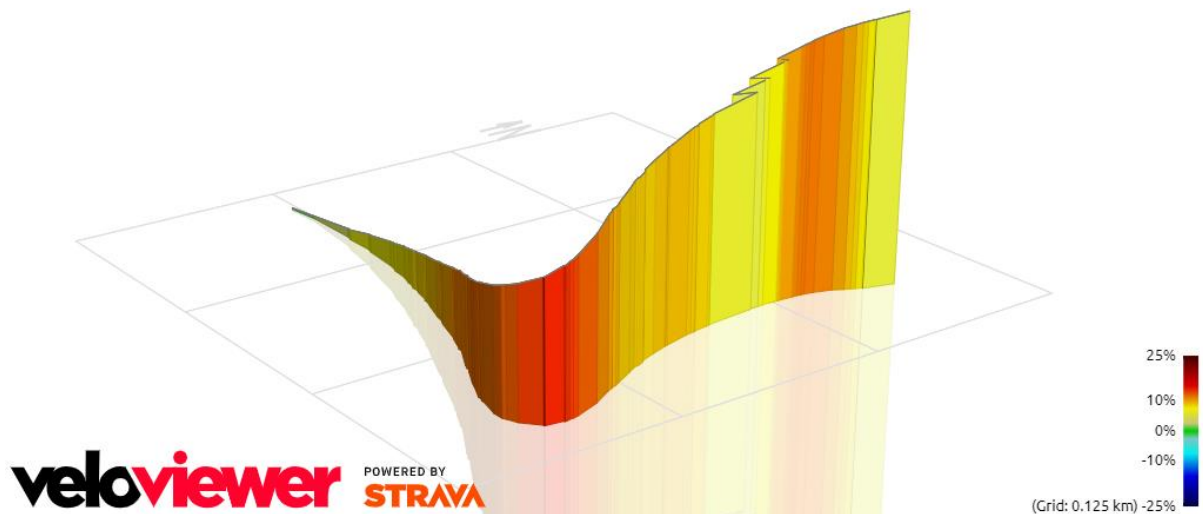

A great evenings racing under lights, and mercifully little rain took place at Hardwick Hall on Sunday night. The Hill is usually closed to riders as it is the one way exit for visitors. The climb is 615 metres long with a 55-metre climb mainly in the last third which includes a cattle grid.

With a special juvenile entry (£3) all 13 young riders led off by 8-year-old Albie Saxton of Bolsover and Max Parish of Ilkeston beat the hill including the challenging cattle grid. Enthusiastic Bolsover DCC Go riders took the opportunity to ride with 11-year-old Leila Crookes, becoming the youngest female to beat the hill.
