Race Report: Congratulations to all riders and helpers for providing a fine contest on a hard day. And you all finished Timings measured by the LVCC team of Wezel/Taylor/Keen/Hedges, many thanks to them and to the many marshalls the club were able to provide on this demanding course. Particular gratitude to local man John Calvert who, spotting unexpected roadworks during the week, went back there and negotiated a reopening of the road for the weekend. But for that, no race!! On a cool day going out into a NW breeze, he managed a commendable 1:16:41. That was after the Tandem pairing of Iszaat and Lubin, again deprived of competition by mishap, did a fine 1:10:49. With the Ladies event also hit by absence, Lisa Hurrell beat Emma Flin. The first seed to start, and long time "clubhouse" (if only!) leader was James Jenkins in 1:03:09. Fastest unseeded rider almost to the end was Samuel Thienen in 1:09:33, beaten late on by last year's 5th placed Rob Chaplin, leaving them 6th and 7th. Although the first 4 last year didn't enter (or scratched) Rob was unseeded this year in an even stronger field. That certainly goes for scratchman Harry Tanfield, a pro with World Tour team AG2R-La Mondiale. But first, the other seeds raced to their appropriate placings behind the exceptional Jenkins, with local "cracks" David Harding 3rd, Kevin Baumber 4th and Chris Potter 5th. Dan Ryan, Matt Donovan and Matthew Saunders rounded out the top ten, all under evens! But Harry Tanfield did not disappoint. Overtaking many, and hurtling through the lanes and roundabouts, he smashed course and event record with an astonishing, on the day, 1:00:30! A good bloke too, cheers, Harry, and well done everyone, see you all next year in the socially undistanced sunshine...?
