## Summary and Thanks

Thank you to all the riders for supporting this event, which is now in its sixth year.

This is the second year we have run this event under Covid restrictions, however everyone behaved exemplary so thank you for adhering to the rules.

Unfortunately the weather wasn't as memorable as the results. Damp roads, hail, the odd patch of sunshine and a stiff breeze that became a headwind on the Ashfield to Occold section of the course, together with only 9 degs air temperature, made for a chilly ride!

The Renny Stirling Memorial Trophy was won by Lloyd Chapman of Loose Cannon's Conditioning, which, considering the conditions, posted a very solid time of 42:40. The female category was won by Hannah O'Brien, also of Loose Cannons Conditioning, with a time of 50:01.

The team prize makes it a grand slam for Loose Cannon's Conditioning with trio Chapman, Staines and O'Brien coming home with a combined time of 02:18:28.

Finally, in the 2up TTT event that preceded the solo riders, this was a clean - one two - sweep for Orwell Velo with Messers Aikin & Freeman rolling home in 44:37 followed by duo Crabtree and Sherwood in second place with 45:28, all on road machines.

Another huge thank you to our event sponsors - Anson Timberworks for the fabulous trophy, Dayle Bayliss Ltd for donating the prize money and Stonham Barns Park for the use of the venue and facilities. It was also great to see riders bringing their families to the venue and supporting our hosts business.

All the money raised from this event will be directly invested into the youth team (16-18 year olds). For the 2021 season and beyond, one of our key objectives is to focus time, resource and effort into the next generation of riders to keep this sport thriving locally.
