Many thanks to all the riders that supported our event on the 15th Sept. Thanks also to all who helped in organising and running the event again this year. We didn't quite get the conditions we were after but that didn't stop some great rides on the day.

Things started off with an on/off mist and spells of rain over the top of the Cat & Fiddle, but we hoped for better conditions as the day went on. We'd had to put the start time back so as not to clash with a sportive on the same day, so started the event at 14:00. With a revised start time, it was a bit grim compared to the fantastic weather that we'd seen for the Tour of Britain this week.

In the ladies' event, Lucy Lee from Velo Club Melyd, set a fast time to start with a 23:36.1 and wasn't caught by anyone in the field, taking the event win from 2nd place lady Jessica Evans of ASSOS Equipe UK with 24:02.7. A superb and confident time given the conditions.

The men's event also started in a similar vein, with Ed Lavarack from Swift Carbon Pro Racing setting a blistering time in less than ideal conditions of 18:31.2. Just the day after he finished riding the Tour of Britain with his team.

It wasn't until rider 25, Dan Evans finished with 18:46.5, that we saw a time anywhere near the fastest run, which gave him 3rd place after one rider came near in the form of Richard Bussell, rider 30 of Aerocoach with 18:33.5. This completed a trio of times under 19 minutes on a tough day.

In the team event, Macclesfield Wheelers were pipped by B38/Cycles In Motion.

I trust all riders enjoyed the day, despite conditions. I hope to see you all again next year.
