Course Description D30/11

START at T-junction of unclassified road to Ellerdine & Rowton on A442 ½ mile north of Waters Upton. 0.00 miles Proceed north on A442 to Espley island. 5.15 miles **Turn right** taking 3rd exit and proceed north east on A53 to Tern Hill island. 8.48 miles **Go straight over**, taking 2nd exit to continue along A53 to Muller island. 9.68 miles **Go straight over**, taking 1st exit to continue along A53 to Drayton Meadows island. 11.43 miles. **Go straight over**, taking 1st exit along A53 to Market Drayton island. 12.72 miles. **Encircle** island taking 4th exit and retrace along A53 to Drayton Meadows island 13.68 miles **Go straight over** and continue on A53 to Muller island. 14.38 miles **Go straight over** taking 2nd exit t along A53 to Tern Hill island and continue along A53 to Espley island. 17.71 miles **Turn left**, taking 1st exit and proceed south along A442 to Shawbirch island. 27.10 miles. **Encircle** island, taking 4th exit and proceed north on A442 to **FINISH** at blue paint mark on bridge over brook at Slep approx. 0.2 miles before Crudgington crossroads. 30.00 miles.

There will be no “pusher-off” at the start for this event.



IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL COMPETITORS

Please note CTT regulations requiring a working front as well as rear light and the compulsory use of helmets for all competitors:

In accordance with Regulation 14(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine **a working rear red light, either flashing or constant**, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

In accordance with Regulation 14(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine **a working front white light, either flashing or constant**, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users

In accordance with Regulation 15 - **All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet** which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard.

There will be a separate start line official checking compliance with the regulations. Any competitor not in compliance will not be allowed to start.

AT NO TIME SHOULD RIDERS PERFORM U-TURNS IN THE ROAD

PLEASE KEEP YOUR HEAD UP AT ALL TIMES

Tern Hill Roundabout. Local District Regulations require riders to negotiate this RAB in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. **Riders must not use their tri-bars/extensions between the first bollard they pass on entering the island and the last bollard they pass on leaving it.** Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

Road Bike Category Rules

For those who entered as road bike category - The CTT road bike category has a consistent and simple set of rules nationwide:

- The road bike can possess drop or straight handlebars
- No tri-bars, clip-on bars or Spinacci bars are allowed
- No disc wheels
- Both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each
- The maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm
