Event HQ is Greatham Village Hall & will be Signposted from Ham Barn Roundabout A3

To the Start: (12 minutes) Turn left outside of the Village Hall and continue to Longmoor Road on the right, go up the road until you come out onto the slip road to the A325 (take care). Turn left & take the first exit onto the A325 where you can ride down to the start. There is no need to go back & forth to the start as we do not move it once the event has started.

It is a "rubbish start", but I haven't worked out a better start that is legitimate distance to the finish point, you should be able to get it out of the way soon & you don't have to come back to it.

When you have finished take care coming up to the Ham Barn roundabout and take the third exit towards Greatham and HQ **please** make your intentions clear to any following traffic. Also don't sit up, there will be other riders & traffic behind you. You will arrive at the village hall from the opposite direction. It is the normal summer 10 HQ.

If caught, ease back; do not take pace on the wheel of the rider who caught you

Look where you are going, keep your head up & please don't hog the carriageway.

Prizes: they will be presented to the first three in either gender plus team. They will be presented *quickly* after the Events, please stay and applaud the Victors of the Day. Paddy & Martin will also issue a result sheet "on the day". **Prizes not collected on the day** will be deemed to have been donated, unless prior arrangements have been made.

Start at Greatham on the A325 (Woolmer Road) approximately 75 yards south east of Greatham Roundabout and approximately 25 yards northwest of BT covers. Head towards and circle the Greatham Roundabout retracing on A325 and towards the Longmoor Bridge going straight on at the small roundabout, cross the flyover to join the A3 towards Portsmouth / Petersfield (0.80 mile).

Stay on the **A3** crossing Ham Barn Roundabout until the Liss turning (half a mile past the lay-by); turn in to the slip road then at the roundabout take the second exit, then bear right following signs for A3 Guildford. Go over the flyover to rejoin A3 (4.5 miles) and proceed north.

Continue along A3 to Ham Barn Roundabout, **Approaching Ham Barn Roundabout stay in the middle lane & take 2nd Exit** and continue north on the A3. Proceed north passing turnings for the (1) A325 (Farnham) (2) Griggs Green, at the third turning (11.3 miles) take the left turn signposted Haslemere / Liphook, and continue over the flyover taking the left turn onto the slip road to rejoin the A3 in a southerly direction (signposted Petersfield / Portsmouth).

Retrace along A3 towards the Ham Barn Roundabout and take the second exit as before (still on the A3). Once again take the Liss Slip Road & then go directly over roundabout bearing right following sign A3 Guildford. Go over the fly-over to rejoin A3 (as before).

Rejoin A3 as before and retrace outward route up the A3 via Ham Barn Roundabout (20.10 miles) to the Liphook flyover and back down A3 to finish at a point 10 yards south of entry to lay-by, after passing under bridge and 0.554m north of Liss/Selborne RBT (Ham Barn) (30 miles). (It is where the P881/10, P884b/15, P884b/25 finishes)

Any Mileage Markers will refer to the last lap
