Proceed via "Intake Lane" and "Lodge Lane" to Wheatsheaf Island, where left along A570 to Motorway Island. Encircle island & follow A570 via Wheatsheaf Island to Mossborough Island. Encircle island & follow A570 to Wheatsheaf Island where left into "Lodge Lane" & "Intake Lane" to FINISH at second gate post into plantation.
