POINTS

Points will be awarded on the basis of 60 points (in each category) for the winner down to 1 for sixtieth place in each event. The winners will be the riders with the highest aggregate total of points from up to four events. If more than one rider achieves the same number of points, then their 5th highest placing will be used to determine the winner. The Veteran categories are open to both Men and Women. Women Veterans will receive an additional 8 years on Target Time. The Veterans competitions will be run over the same distance as the Women's competition. The competition for Paracyclist's is based on a "Factored Time" system.

Any rider or supporter who believes they may have symptoms of Covid 19, or has been told to self- isolate, or is on the current list for shielding should not attend this event.

It is compulsory to have a working back light, visible to other road users and for it to be working/switched on at the start. No light- no start.

HQ: We will have an outdoor HQ at Church Warsop Parish Centre, Bishops Walk, Church Warsop, Mansfield NG 20 0SN. There is limited parking here for 10-15 vehicles and toilets will be available.

Please bring your own pen to sign on with and your own safety pins if required. Numbers will be supplied at sign on. Do not cut your numbers down. You will be required to wear a number on your arm, so bring extra safety pins. On completion of your race, please sign off and place your number in the bucket of disinfectant supplied. Failure to sign off will result in a DNF.

Hand sanitiser will be available. We request you wear a face mask for signing on and maintain 2 metres distance from other riders, organisers and marshalls at all times.

Do not socialise with other riders before or after the event.

If you are unable to park at the venue, please park without inconveniencing local residents. No parking in the vicinity of the start or finish. Large car parks are available at Thoresby Hall, Clumber Park and in Worksop town, all within a 5 mile radius of start.

Sadly, we are unable to provide any refreshments or water for this race, so ensure you bring whatever you need with you.

Do not warm up on the course once the event has started and do not u-turn within sight of the start or finish. Keep your head up whilst riding, at all times. The race organisers and CTT strongly recommend you wear a hard shell helmet that meets international safety standards.

It is compulsory to have a working back light, visible to other road users and for it to be working/switched on at the start. No light- no start.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control. It is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control and to comply accordingly- race numbers of required competitors will be

available at the signing on/off point and you should attend after your race has finished without delay.

1 Vet Male & Female- £20 (Vet= over 40 years of age on race day)

Course: O14C - description

This event is being run on the O14C course.

Start at point marked 10 approx 140 yds south of gateway on western side of A60 and 400 yds south of A632 X roads at Cuckney. Proceed northwards on A60 through Cuckney to traffic island A619 junction west of Worksop (5.396 miles). Turn left onto A619 and proceed west to Gapsick Lane (9.100 miles). Turn left onto Gapsick Lane and proceed south to give way with A616 (10.000 miles). Turn left onto A616 and proceed south east, through Creswell, to finish 50 yds before entering Cuckney, marked by 30mph limit signs (14.700 miles)

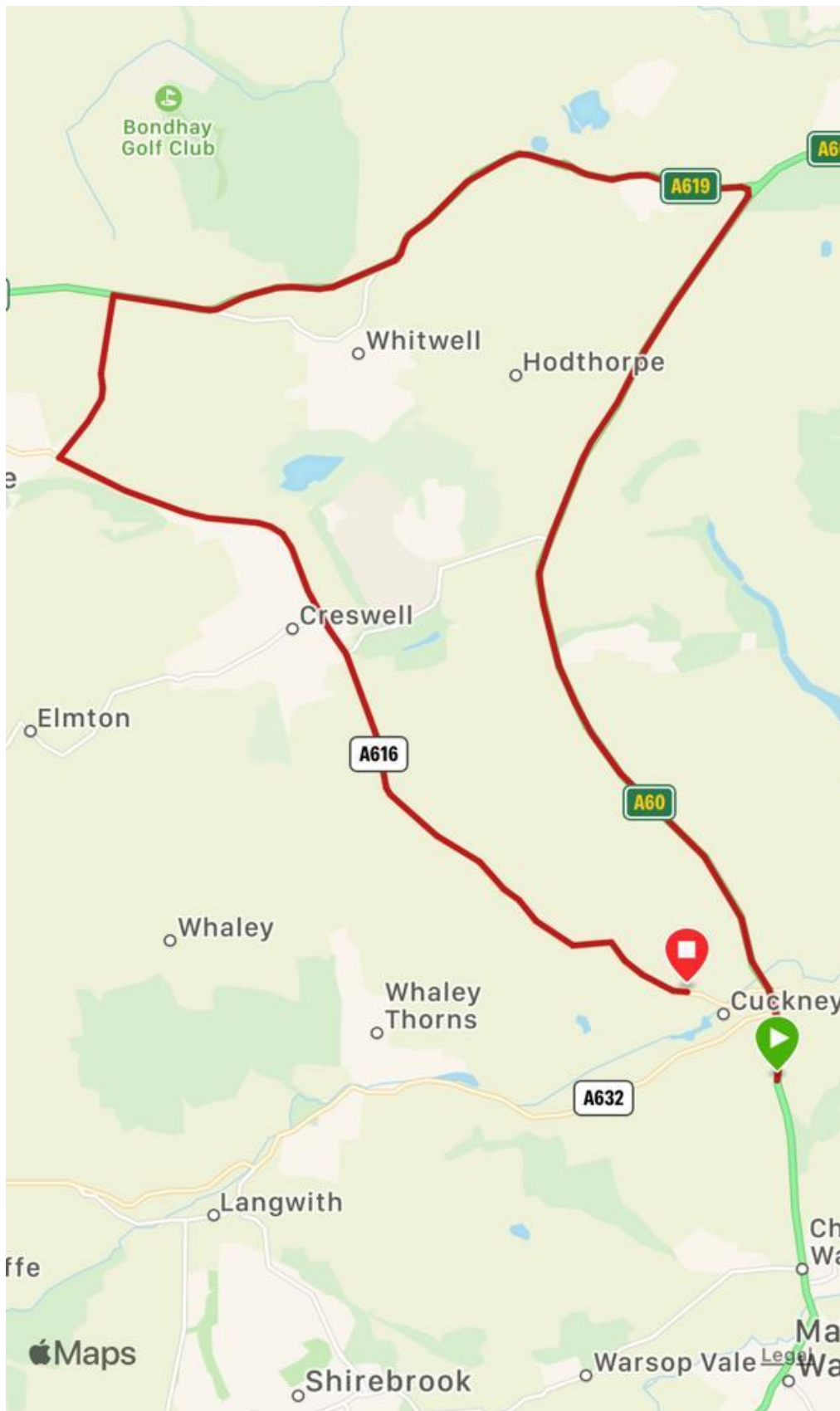

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

ROAD BIKE CRITERIA

- No tri bars, clip on bars or Spinaci bars
- No disc wheels. Both front and rear wheels must have a minimum of 12 spokes each. The maximum rim depth on all wheels is 65mm
- No aero helmet or a helmet that covers the ears or a helmet with a visor is to be used
- Riders must not ride with their forearms resting on the handlebars at any time

NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

REGULATION 14(i)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF. N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY,

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15, all competitors under the age of 18 and/or juniors **MUST** wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
