## **COVID-19 CTT Instructions**

- Respect Covid-19 Conditions & Protocol, read the Race Manual.
- Park and walk with social distancing in mind. Bring and use a facemask.
- Please bring your own pen and safety pins (if required).
- Toilets will be available at HQ, however these are not to be used as changing facilities.
- No items/clothing to be left at the start or with the timekeeper and no pusher off.
- No more than 5 riders, 2m apart, to wait at the start.
- After racing please sign out with your own pen and leave your number in the bowl at HQ.
- Please leave the car parking area in a timely and quiet fashion.

#### **Procedure During the Event**

- No Light = No Ride.
- HEAD UP look where you are going. Sometimes cars stop on the carriageway. Please don't hog the carriageway.
- If caught, ease back; do not take pace on the wheel of the rider who caught you.
- If passing a rider please make sure the effort is enough to pass completely.
- Please call out your number as you finish.

#### Parking

• Please use the free car park at the Village Hall but be aware this is a residential area and many will (sensibly!) still be in their beds so please keep the noise levels down, no noisy turbo's please.

## **Course Description P881**


## Course & National Record: Marcin Bialoblocki 00:26:35 (24/07/19) Women's & National Record: Emma Lewis 00:29:48 (05/06/19)

Start on the hard shoulder on the southbound slip road to the A3 at Longmoor (A325) three metres from the start of the Armco barrier. Proceed to the slip road onto the southbound A3 towards Petersfield.

Take 2nd exit (straight on) and continue on A3 until reaching the 1<sup>st</sup> exit slip road signposted Liss (1/2 mile past the lay-by) where take this exit slip road to the Princes Bridge RAB (SU 770270). Take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (straight on) and follow the road around to the right following the sign A3 Guildford to cross Prince's Bridge Flyover (3.08 Miles) and down the slip road to rejoin A3 towards London and Guildford. Continue along A3 to Ham Barn Roundabout, Approaching Ham Barn Roundabout stay in the middle lane & take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit (5 miles).

Proceed passing turnings for: (1) A325 (Farnham); (2) Griggs Green, past the Service Station then at the third turning (10.2 miles) take the slip road signposted Haslemere / Liphook, and continue over the flyover taking the left turn onto the slip road to rejoin the A3 in a southerly direction (signposted Petersfield / Portsmouth).

Retrace along A3 southbound towards the Ham Barn Roundabout passing the Griggs Green turning (12.2 mile) pass the starting area at Longmoor to finish at the entrance on the lay-by approximately 600 yards north of Ham Barn roundabout (15 miles). Do not ride into the lay by at the finish.



# P884/15b Time trial course

## Ride to the start:

Turn left outside of the Village Hall (or Eurotec car park) and continue to the end of the road where turn

right on to the A325 roundabout where take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit towards the A3. When you reach the roundabout on top of the A3 go straight over to the 'holding area' above the A3 and 50 meters from the start. There is no need to go back & forth to the start as we do not move it once the event has started.

When you have finished take care coming up to the Ham Barn roundabout and take the third exit towards Greatham and HQ. You will arrive at the village hall from the opposite direction. It is the normal summer HQ.

## Ride back from the finish:

Don't stop after the finish line but continue riding towards Ham Barn RAB. Move into the outside lane with care and go right on the RAB toward Greatham. At the left hand bend turn right into Greatham Village and continue to HQ.
