From HQ to Start:

PLEASE AVOID USING THE COURSE TO GET TO THE START (IE VIA TWEMLOW LANE) ONCE THE EVENT HAS STARTED

It is approximately 5 miles from the HQ to the Start. Please allow sufficient time.

Turn left out of the HQ onto the A50. Take the second road of the right (Goostrey Lane). Continue through Goostrey Village and turn left (Blackden Lane) just before the Church. Continue on this road until you reach the start just past the entrance to Jodrell Bank.

Course Description

J2/9 Bomish Lane - Chelford - Seven Sisters - Cranage - Twemlow circuit (25 miles)

Start Bomish lane left on to the A535 to Chelford Island. Left here along to Ollerton. Left turn on to 7 sister's lane and along here to the A50. Caution here left turn and continue along the A50 to Cranage turning left at Twemlow lane. Continue up here to the A535 and turn left. Along here passing Bomish lane (start) continuing to Chelford Island. Same as above with finish on the A50 just passed Mangoletsi's Alfa Romeo Garage.

Riders must continue past the finish with no stopping and be very mindful riders behind might be on their out lap and retrace the way back to the HQ.

Local Regulations

- All riders must have a rear light mounted on their bike - no light, no ride
- Care At Road Junctions. Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.
- Vehicles must not be parked, however briefly, in any part of the access area to Mount Pleasant Nursing Home, opposite the finish."
- Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders MUST NOT approach and encircle the island using tri-bars. Remember - traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action
- Riders must take extra care when exiting from Seven Sisters Lane onto the A50.
- Be aware that there is a double bend shortly after turning into Twemlow Lane at Cranage. Riders need to anticipate this and be prepared to negotiate it in a safe manner. In wet weather the metal covers and edges become a skid risk. Please take care.
