### Directions to HQ from A45

From the centre of Dunchurch (A45/A426 cross roads) take the A426 towards Rugby. Proceed on A426 for 0.3 mile. Dunchurch Village Hall is on the right. For those with Sat-Navs the post code is CV22 6PN and the map ref. is 486 717. You can see more about the hall on their website

### Parking at Dunchurch Village Hall

There is an off-road car park next to the hall. If the car park is full proceed to the far side of the car park and park on the grass as near to the fence by the main road as possible. Do not park on the main road through the village.

Please do **not** park on the actual course or at the start and finish.

### Numbers

Numbers will be available at the event headquarters. **Note that riders are required to sign off when handing in their number after finishing.**

NB. Riders' PBs are used for field placement in accordance with CTT guidelines.

### Directions to the Start

From the HQ turn left onto the A426 and proceed to the cross roads (traffic lights) at the centre of Dunchurch. Turn right onto the A45 (signpost Coventry). At the A45/M45 island follow the sign to Coventry (dual carriageway). The start is in the first lay-by immediately on the left. The total distance from the HQ to the start is 1.9 miles.

### Event Categories & Prizes:

**Men:** £50, £40, £30

**Women:** £50, £40, £30

**Road Bikes:** £30, £25, £20

**Vet on Std:** £30, £25, £20

**Fastest Junior:** £20

**Age Categories\*** £15 per category

**Fastest Team of 3** £15 per rider

NB. One prize per rider, excluding team prizes. Where riders are eligible for more than one prize the higher monetary value will apply. If the prize value is the same the order of the prize list will determine priority.

Prizes for best Junior, Vet on Std & Age Cats could be from any of the Men's event, Women's event or Road Bikes event.

\*.Age categories (Based on age on day of event):

A 40-44, B 45-49, C 50-54, D 55-59, E 60-64, F 65-69, G 70 +.

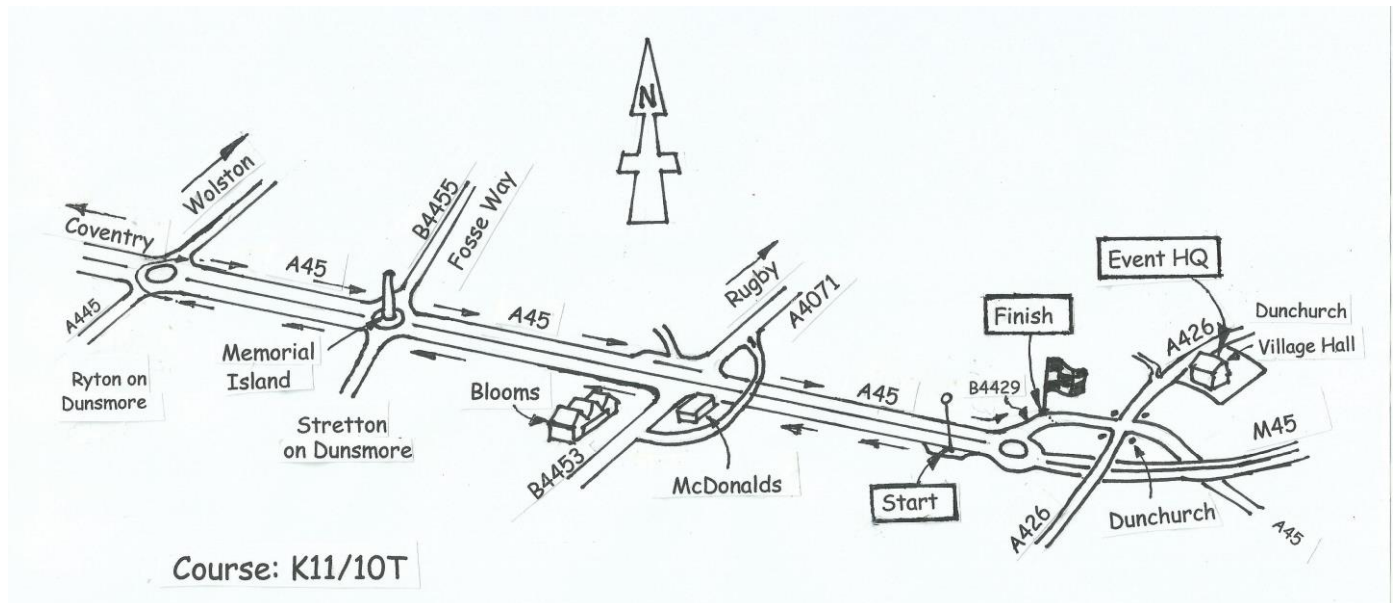
## Road Bike Definition:

1. No aerobars, clip on aerobars or aero extensions to be used
2. Hands must be holding the handlebars at all times whilst racing (ie. not with forearms resting on the handlebar)
3. Wheels must have a minimum of 12 spokes each, and have a maximum rim depth of 65 mm
4. Helmets to have no visor
5. Ears must not be covered by the helmet (Giro Aerohead helmets are not permitted)

Once the Event has started at 14:00, no competitor shall use any part of the course for warming up prior to their start time. Any rider doing so risks disqualification.

SP 460 718	Start in lay-by 200 yds west of the A45/M45 Thurlaston island, at the 3rd join in the concrete apron.	0
SP 415 732	At island junction with B4455 (Fosse way) take second exit (A45)	3.146
SP 391 741	At island junction with A445 encircle the island to retrace (A45)	4.776
SP 415 732	Past island at junction with B4455 (Fosse way)	6.384
SP 465 715	At A45/M45 turn left (B4429)	9.649
SP 469 714	Finish 60 yards past the turn to Thurlaston (Main Street), in line with the eastern and the exposed gate post immediately past the property named "Newhaven."	10
