Cheque will be sent to award winners following confirmation of final results and in the week following the event.

TI54: COURSE DETAILS - START opposite the second No Through Road sign on the roundabout and head south signed A6055 Catterick and continue on this road for (approx 5.9miles) until the first roundabout, taking the FOURTH EXIT marked A684 Leyburn (Bedale B6285) with care and continue in a westerly direction to the next roundabout ENCIRCLE it (7.65miles) and return in the opposite direction on the A684 signed Northallerton, until the next roundabout (9.4miles) take the FIRST EXIT left with care marked A6055 North, proceed in a northerly direction for approximately 5.7 miles and FINISH opposite the large Blue motorway sign marked The North/The South A1(M) (15.1miles)

This is the first time this course has been, so winner will set course record. The road on which this course covers produced a 17 minute 10 mile time in 2018. The surface is new and smooth with no potholes.

RIDERS NOTES:

SIGNING ON: SIGNING IN & OUT SHEET, BODY NUMBERS & RESULTS will be available to collect from the HQ. Please return number after your ride, sign out and enjoy drinks and food. The headquarters will be open from 8.00am

DO NOT FORGET - FAIL TO SIGN OUT = DNF

2019 TEESSIDE GUIDELINES:

- 1. Numbers, to be collected from & returned to the Headquarters, where the signing on and out sheet and result board will be located. Any additional hazards identified on the day will be advised on a notice adjacent to the signing on/in sheet.
- 2. No cars other than the event officials to be parked at the start or finish.
- 3. No U turns in sight of the start.
- 4. Riders are not to warm up on any part of the course, whilst an event is being held
- 5. No turbo trainers are to be used for warming up within 100 metres of inhabited properties.

SAFETY:

- Always give priority to traffic from your right when negotiating roundabouts.
- Be aware the first roundabout you will encounter, where you take the 4TH exit, is at the bottom of a descent, so please approach with caution and in a safe manner.
- Signal clearly to other road users the course you intend to take.
- Safety not your performance is the first priority at all times. Anyone caught riding in a "head down" position may face a disqualification and/or disciplinary action.
- CTT regulations require competitors under 18 years of age to wear a helmet of hard/soft shell construction and recommends the use helmets by all other competitors.

WHEN FIXING YOUR NUMBER VIA THE PINS PROVIDED OR BY USE OF THE INTERGRAL POCKET IN YOUR SKINSUIT, PLEASE DO NOT FOLD THEM AS THIS CAUSES DAMAGE TO THE NUMBERS AND SHORTENS THEIR LIFE SPAN. IT ALSO CONTRAVENES THE CTT REGULATIONS TO DO SO. IN ADDITION, AS A CONTRIBUTING SAFETY FEATURE, THE FULL NUMBER ON SHOW ACTS AS AN 8 INCH FLUORESCENT SIGN TO OTHER ROAD USERS APPROACHING FROM THE REAR THAT THERE IS A RIDER AHEAD.

2019 Teesside District Road Bike Specification



To enter a 2019 road bike specific event in the Teesside District, the following specification is appropriate to the conditions of entry:

The Rider:

- No time trial style pointy helmets (including Kask Bambino), or helmets with built in visors should be worn.
- Use of skinsuits is permitted
- No riding with elbows or forearms on the handlebars. If witnessed, competitor will be disqualified.

The Cycle:

- The frame should be constructed in the traditional pattern, i.e. built around a main triangle.
- No time trial style or triathlon forward extension bars with or without elbow pads should be present.
- Wheels should be of a spoked construction, with a minimum of 12 spokes and a maximum depth of 60mm.

Please apply the spirit of the road bike competition in your equipment choice.
