Course Details. AS/9

- Start at grid reference SK697419 ten yards north of 'clearway' sign on a6097 inside the white line marking edge of slip road onto a46 northbound.
- Start level with drop down kerb, back wheel up against kerb edge which is 90 degrees to the carriageway. (riders can taper onto the slip road as traffic allows/dictates).
- Join A46
- Proceed north until Elston / Thorpe junction.
- Follow junction, sweeping left to turn left at t junction, cross the A46, take first left and sweep to re-join A46 southbound.
- Continue on A46, ignoring all road junctions until Kinoulton.
- Left off A46 and follow junction sweeping left, over the A46, to re-join A46 northbound.
- Continue on A46 until East Bridgeford / Car Colston junction. Left onto slip road.
- At roundabout take 2nd exit onto A6097 to finish at yellow 'Traffic Lights 400 yards'. (27.1 miles / 43.6km).

**AFTER FINISHING: CAUTION THERE ARE TRAFFIC LIGHTS AND A CROSSROAD 400YARDS AHEAD
LIKELY TO BE ON RED.**

Directions to the start from HQ:

The start is approximate 2 miles from the HQ, from the car park follow signs for Newark A46, heading Southeast over the River Trent.

Due to the nature of the start area, a holding pen for waiting riders will be operational, strictly 1 team only behind the timekeepers, **ALL** other riders should wait at the starting pen and await to be called. Please do not warm up on the course, there is a variety of roads close to the start to use for warming up, Shelford Road being an ideal option.

STRICTLY NO PARKING AT THE START.

Parking:

Upon arrival at the HQ you be asked to parked on the adjacent playing fields, race officials, volunteers and CTT representatives will be parked in the hard standing spaces. There is ample race parking available, but the roads to and from the HQ are tight and residential, so please do not park or block on the roads around the HQ, this is especially prevalent along Main Street.

Race Numbers:

Will be available at the HQ and will be issued after signing-on. In accordance with Championship Conditions only numbers provided by the organizer should be used. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and Arm Numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forwards (not inwards). Riders must also sign out at the end of the event. Failure to do so will result in a DNF.

NO FRONT LIGHT = NO RIDE

NO REAR LIGHT = NO RIDE

NO HELMET = NO RIDE

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(j)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

REGULATION 14(i)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 14(j)

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 15

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN1078

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
