START:- On the B184 at GPO pillar box at north end of lay-by at Aythorpe Roding village hall. Proceed north through High Roding to turn at roundabout at junction with Clopton Hall lane (4.6mls). Retrace through High Roding and Aythorpe Roding to FINISH at 2nd drain vent south of triangular "School" sign 192 yards north of end of lay-by at Leaden Roding school.

# NOTES TO RIDERS AND HELPERS AND LOCAL REGULATIONS

#### **LOCAL REGULATION 4.6**

Competitors are not allowed to warm up along the B184 between Aythorpe Roding village hall and Great Dunmow prior or during an event.

#### **LOCAL REGULATION 4.8.2**

NO U-TURNS are allowed within sight of the start or finishing points. Riders carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre are liable to disqualification from the event and further disciplinary action by the District Committee.

#### **PARKING/WARMING UP**

Bearing in mind that you could be in breach of the above local regulation, if you prefer to warm up on the road I would suggest you park using the large lay-by just south of the finish outside Leaden Roding school from where you can use the A1060, from there it is a 3 minute ride to the start at the village hall. If you use a static trainer there is plenty of parking outside the HQ. Please do not use the Axe and Compasses PH car park north of the start.

#### NUMBERS/SIGNING ON/OUT

Will be outside the village hall, on signing out and returning your number please place it in the sanitising bin next to the signing table.

#### START LINE

Please ensure you don't arrive more than 3 minutes before your start time and keep a 2 metre gap between you at all times, there is plenty of space at the start area to be able to do that.

#### **AYTHORPE VILLAGE**

There is some concern around the village that they will be visited by 60 cyclists from some areas with a higher infection rate, that is the reason we have had to change from the original course listed in the CTT handbook as the usual village hall cannot be made available to us. PLEASE ACT AND BE SEEN TO BE ACTING RESPONSIBLY

#### **EVENT HQ**

Only toilet facilities will be available at the village hall with a one-way system in operation please hand sanitise before entering and leaving the building. THERE WILL NOT BE A RESULT BOARD ,REFRESHMENTS OR CHANGING FACILITIES SO PLEASE ARRIVE RACE READY.

### **RACE RESULT**

After you have completed your ride please go home and avoid socialising, the race result will be published before the weekend is out. DO NOT APPROACH THE TIMEKEEPERS.

#### **PUSH OFF START**

No pusher off, start with a foot on the ground. If you jump the start you will be penalised for maybe more than you gained.

## **COVID 19**

Please understand that you must not attend this event if either you or anybody in your household has had COVID-19 symptoms in the last 7days, and if they develop symptoms within 7 days of the event they should inform the event organiser and use the Test ,Track and Trace system to alert others with whom you may have been in contact with.
