

IMPORTANT:

AS A RESULT OF UNSCHEDULED SEWER WORKS THIS WEEK, THE ROAD FROM IFOLD

TO PLAISTOW IS CLOSED FOR ALL BUT PEDESTRIANS AND IS UNLIKELY TO REOPEN TILL

30 AUGUST. IF THIS IS THE SITUATION ON EACH DAY, THEN THESE 2 NEW COURSES WILL BE USED:

"10": Same START, 1st 7 miles the same then (see map in this start sheet) left into Foxbridge Lane past the start (7.8 miles) and continue on 2nd circuit to FINISH after 2 T-junctions in Kirdford, opposite recreation ground.

"25": Same START, do 3 circuits of 7.8 miles (= 23.4 miles) and continue on 4th circuit to FINISH 140 yards north of first T-junction in Kirdford.

Both courses are basically flat, just the drag after Boxal bridge @ 3 miles, and avoid the 2 hills up to Plaistow.

LONDON SOUTH D.C. regulation:

No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start and finish.

No times will be given out at the finish.

Apart from riding to the start, no warming-up on the course once the event has started.

Under 18 years old riders: Bring a completed Parental Consent form to present before signing-on.

No form = No ride

CTT Regulations require the use of a helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards for all competitors.

CTT Regulations now require that no competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, and to the front of their machine, a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that are illuminated and positioned to be clearly visible to other road users.

London South DC strongly recommend that riders do not wear black or dark clothing during any event held on the public road.

Under 18 years old riders: Bring a completed Parental Consent form to present before signing-on. No form = No ride.
