Number collection and signing on will be in the the Village Hall car park from 10:00am.

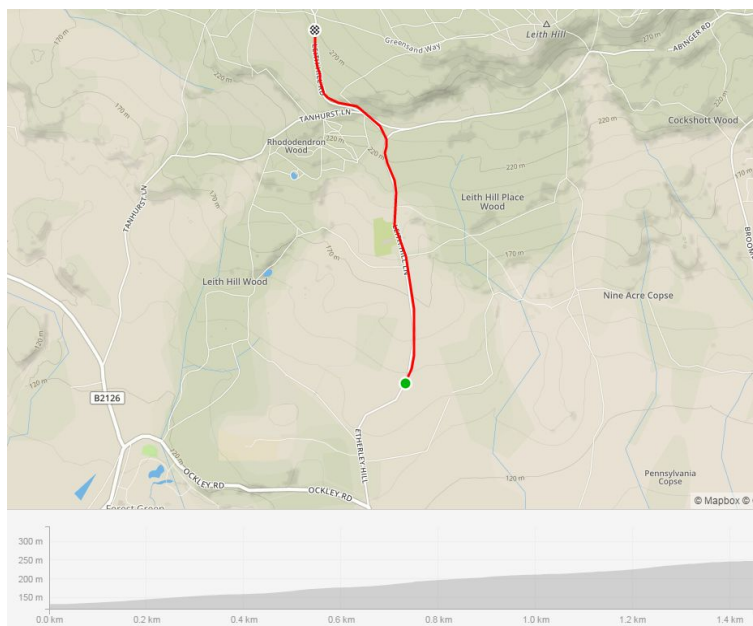
Regulations due to COVID19

- Please note, there is to be no competitor parking in the Village Hall Carpark. The Village Hall area is for sign on and toilets only.
- Please ride to the event if possible. If you need to drive, there are several public car parks around Leith Hill. Please park considerately and do not park in front of any resident's houses or across farm gates. **London South District Regulation: No vehicles shall be parked on the highway within sight of the starting and finishing points.**
- Please bring your own pen and safety pins.
- We have twice as many riders as normal in this event, so due to COVID19 legislation, please try to avoid arriving more than an hour before your start time.
- Warm ups on static trainers are permitted providing you comply with social distancing of at least 2m and you do not warm up on a static trainer in front of any houses or block any farm gates
- You may not warm up on the course once the event has started. Please also avoid driving on the course once the event has started.
- There are some stables nearby. Please pass horses carefully if you encounter them on your warm up.
- Please do not proceed to the start more than 5 minutes before your start time. There must be no more than 3 riders at the start at any one time. Please follow the instructions of the event marshals.
- On completing your race, please move yourself away from the finish as soon as possible. If you descend down the hill, please be mindful of those racing up it.

Any competitor failing to comply with the above regulations will be disqualified from the event.

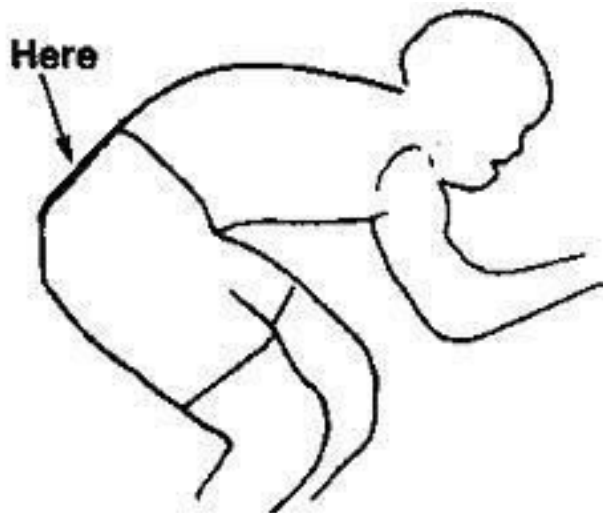
Protective Helmets

All competitors under the age of 18 years and / or Juniors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard / soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078. It is the responsibility of the rider (or parent or guardian if the rider is under 18 years of age) to:

- (a) Select a Helmet that offers protection against head injury and does not restrict the rider's vision or hearing.
- (b) Ensure that the helmet is properly fitted, is undamaged and in good condition.

Competitors under the age of 18 years may only compete with the written consent of their parent or guardian given on the form(s) currently prescribed by the National Committee. **No form – No ride!**

NUMBERS MUST BE FIXED BELOW WAIST



NO TIME MAY BE RECORDED IF NUMBER IS NOT CORRECTLY POSITIONED

ALL RIDERS MUST START WITH A WORKING REAR LIGHT ATTACHED TO THEIR MACHINE - NO LIGHT, NO RIDE

NOTES TO COMPETITORS:**Signing-on Sheet and Signing-out Sheet**

(a) The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official signing-on sheet when collecting their number.

(b) In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must

(i) return their race number(s); and

(ii) sign the official signing-out sheet. A rider who fails to sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

This event may be subject to a Doping Control. As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay.
