Headquarters

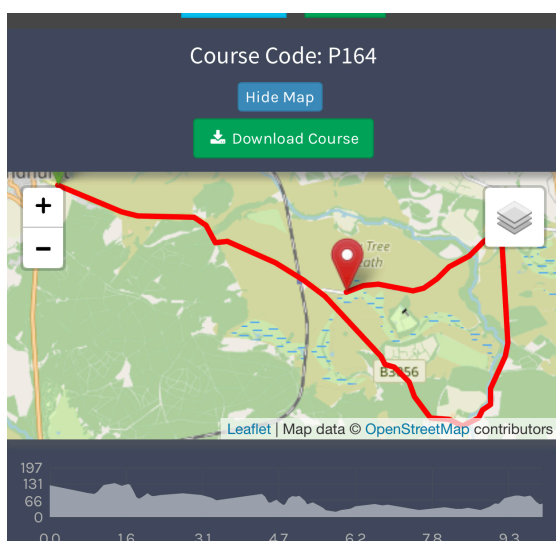
Signing on will be in the entrance to the centre under the canopy. We do have the use of the centres toilets, these are not to be used as changing rooms. The public toilets are open from 8am.

Signing on / off

Signing on will be under the canopy of the entrance to the centre. Where you will have to call out your name and race number you will then be signed in and be given your number. On return and signing out you must once again call your name and race number out wait for acknowledgement and then place your number in the tub next to the table.

Please be aware of the social distancing rules while queuing at HQ and the toilets.

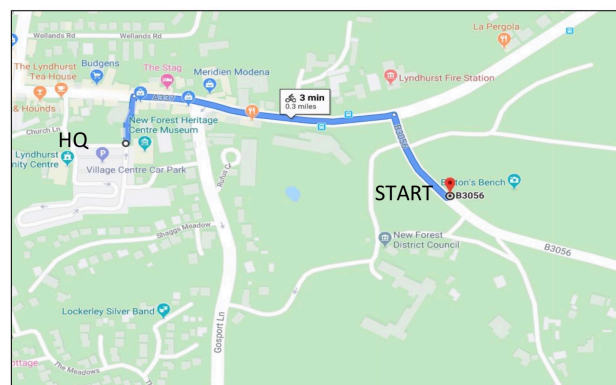
Course



START on B3056 (SU3045 0802), 360 metres SE of junction with A35, at SV marker No.4/9. Ride towards Beaulieu passing over railway at Beaulieu Road Station. Continue to Leygreen Farm (9.1km) and turn left. After 3.9km turn left at Ipley Cross Roads. Pass entrance to Ferny Crofts and FINISH at bottom of hill approx 400 metres east of junction with B3056, at culvert carrying stream under road

To the start

Proceed North out of the Community Centre exit onto the High Street and turn right (with care) into the one way system. Proceed along the High Street being mindful of pedestrians, and continue straight on (past the 'posh' car garage) to then turn right (with care) over the cattle grid into Beaulieu Road B3056. The start is a few hundred yards up on the left. Please allow 5 minutes journey time



Back to HQ after finish

After finishing, continue to junction off Beaulieu road and turn right with care (oncoming vehicles and riders still competing). Please ride in single file therefore not to cause any disruption to riders still racing. Follow the B3056 Beaulieu Road all the way back past the start area. With care, go over the cattle grid to turn left onto the A35 High Street. Proceed to bear left into the one way system keeping to the right hand lane where take the first right turn back into the main car park / Community Centre.

Safety instructions

- ~Beware of forest animals on the road all round the course – and motorists stopping because of them.
- ~ Not do U-turns at the start or finish, within sight of the timekeeper.
- ~Beware of traffic emerging from Car Parks and campsites around the course.
- ~Take extra care on Beaulieu Road Station bridge which is narrow with reduced visibility.
- ~Take care of the lumpy tree root under the tarmac just after the railway bridge and at the sign just past the hotel.
- ~Take care on left turn at Leygreen which has reduced visibility and possibility of gravel.
- ~Take care on left turn at Ipley crossroads which may have gravel. This is a sharp turn and is very easy to stray over the white line. There may be oncoming traffic!
- ~After finishing, take care on right turn at Beaulieu Road Junction heading back towards the HQ. There will be two way traffic including riders still competing.

Any rider observed riding in a manner which may jeopardise his or her own safety, the safety of others and the future of the Sport will be disqualified and reported to the South District Council of Cycling Time Trials.

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise competitors to wear a hard shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards. Under CTT regulations, ALL competitors under the age of 18 must wear a hard shell helmet. You must now use a working rear light either flashing or fixed, positioned on the bike to be clearly visible to following road users. This is now a compulsory requirement, any rider not having a rear light will not be able to start the event.

DO NOT FORGET A WORKING REAR LIGHT

Race Protocol

Participants will be asked to maintain social distancing. No gatherings in groups, no turbo trainer warm up . If you arrive early you will be permitted to ride on the roads to warm up or sit in your car. We will have 6 waiting spaces marked out plus the rider waiting to race at the start line, therefore please only arrive at the start line a maximum of 6 minutes before your time listed. You will not be permitted to wait if you arrive earlier.

Please do not bring friends or family members: they will not be permitted to leave their car. The only exception to this is minors who can be accompanied by a guardian from within their own household or “bubble”. They are however not permitted to enter the start area.

Riders are not permitted to ride on course with a number on their back. There are plenty of other roads where warm up is possible without riding on the course. Please be mindful of racers when arriving by bicycle.

The Time Keepers will be wearing face coverings and will be checking that riders a) have their number attached and, b) have a working rear light. If either of these are missing you will not be permitted to race . There will be no “pusher offer” and you will have to do a standing start on your own. Rolling starts will not be permitted.

Make it easy for the finish time keepers, when you cross the line, shout your number. As loud as you can. Do not approach the finish time keeper at any point for any reason. Once you have finished your race return to HQ to sign out

Race results

There will be no results at HQ. I will aim to add provisional results during the race or shortly after on New forest cycling club Facebook page which is open to all. Final results will be added to CTT asap.

In these unusual circumstances we find ourselves having to change the way we run events. The team has put a lot of work into making sure we are able to follow the government guidelines, the CTT guidance and make sure that the risk to you, us and the general public of transmitting or catching COVID-19 are kept to an absolute minimum. These restrictions are not here to make life difficult for you or the volunteer team, they are here for the above reasons but also to ensure that we are allowed to run these events. We would like to thank all our volunteers and hope that you enjoy the event.
