# WE PLAN TO HOLD THE PRESENTATION AT ABOUT 11.00AM. PLEASE STAY AND SUPPORT YOUR 2022 50 MILE TIME TRIAL CHAMPIONS

**Event Headquarters:** Conyers School, Greens Lane, Yarm. TS15 9ET. The school will be open from 06:00am on the Sunday Morning

**Directions to Headquarters from A1M:** Turn off A1M at Dishforth junction, onto A168 signed, Thirsk/Teesside. Continue on A168 northwards to join A19 towards Teesside. At A67 junction, sign posted Yarm, follow slip road to left to pass Kirklevington village. At first roundabout, turn left and the school is on the right hand side of road. The school is approximately 1.25 miles from the A19

There is sufficient parking at Convers School and in the adjoining car park.

By Train: Yarm Station is approx 200yds from HQ. It is on the York/Middlesbrough line.

There is very limited available parking in the large layby local to the finish point.

**Please remember** that except for the two turns, the A19 carriageway is a clearway, patrolled regularly by both North Yorkshire Police and Highways England, so please no stopping or handing up drinks on this road

# **Course T502/1 Description**

T502/1: Start on east side of Crathorne bridge, proceed to join A19 southbound carraigeway. Continue south on A19, passing Cleveland Tontine hotel (6.7mls), to the Thirsk by-pass where join A168 to Dishforth. At Dishforth, bear left off A168, (24.8 mls) and proceed to round-about, where turn right, crossing the A168 to turn right at round-about. Continue straight on at the next round-about, to join A168 north-bound. (25.7mls) Continue North, retracing outward leg via A168/A19, to bear left off A19 onto A67, to finish at the south end of the large layby approx 250 yds past Crown public house, Kirklevington. (50 mls)

# **Directions from Conyers School to Start (approx 1.25 miles):**

On exiting school TURN LEFT and proceed to roundabout where TAKE 3<sup>rd</sup> EXIT onto A67 and proceed south to bridge over A19. The start is at the expansion joint at the east side of bridge.

# Directions from Finish back to Conyers School (approx 3/4 miles):

On passing the finish, riders should continue on A67 and TAKE 1<sup>st</sup> EXIT from 1<sup>st</sup> roundabout, where school is located APPROX 250YDS ON THE RIGHT.

# **Numbers & Signing On**

The headquarters will be open from 6:00am for signing on and number collection

Both body and arm numbers will be used

In accordance with Championship Conditions, only numbers provided by the organiser shall be used. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forward

The numbers provided to you will be yours to keep, as a memento of your participation in the 2022 Championship on Teesside

You need to ensure that you return, following your ride, to the signing out desk in the event headquarters to sign out. You must sign in and out yourself. Failure to sign out will result in a DNF being recorded against a rider's name

All riders must personally make themselves available at the Headquarters following their ride, as they may be required for drug testing, if UKAD are in attendance

Refreshments will be available at the HQ from 6.00am

# **SAFETY MATTERS**

# New 2022 Cycling Time Trials regulations require:

- A HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard must be worn by all competitors.
- A WORKING FRONT LIGHT either flashing or constant must be fitted to the machine in a position visible to oncoming road users.
- In addition, a WORKING REAR LIGHT either flashing or constant must be fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users.

To comply with the requirements of Highway England, no signage will be displayed on the A19/A168 carriageway, however all major junctions leading onto the A19 will be appropriately signed to advise other road user that an event is taking place

Marshals, wearing high visibility jackets, will be placed at junctions to indicate directions to be followed. They are not in place to interfere with traffic movement.

When negotiating corners, please ensure that you do not cross the centre white line. Non compliance with this request could lead to disqualification.

Spectators are reminded that the A19 is a clearway and that the Road Traffic Act regarding clearways must be adhered to.

As the headquarters and journey to the start are situated local to residential properties and bearing in mind the time of day these events are taking place, please do not use turbo trainers to warm up on within 100 yards of these domestic properties

There shall be no U turns undertaken within sight of the start officials

## NOTES TO COMPETITORS

#### NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(i)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

#### **USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

#### **REGULATION 14(i)**

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

#### **REGULATION 14(j)**

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

#### **REGULATION 15**

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.

#### **REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET**

- (a)The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.
- (b)In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.
- N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

## THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is upto you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay
