Start on the B2080 at the junction of hedge and fence on the north side of the Green and East of the lane to Finchden Manor, Leigh Green at GR 901330. Proceed through Reading Street to Appledore Heath. Turn left (CARE) (M) to Woodchurch where the road becomes the B2067. Bear left through Brook Street to finish at the verge immediately after the lane to Finchden Manor (GR909380)

Please note that all competitors are now required to sign out when returning their number. Failure to do so will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

New Regulation

14(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A (Open) or Type B (Club) event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Riders must not warm up / turn in sight of the start finish areas
- All riders under the age of 18 years must wear a properly fixed helmet that complies with recognised standards
- CTT and the event promoter strongly advise all other riders to wear protective headgear
- Riders who currently use an inhaler for medical reasons must register this fact with British Cycling to satisfy UCI, CTT and BC Anti-Doping Regulations.
- It is an offence for a competitor in any event to use or to have administered to him any proscribed substance that might affect his competitive performance. A rider receiving medical treatment, which could include a proscribed substance, must not compete in time trials.
