First rider off at 10.01 a.m
Head Quarters - Rabbit Hill Business Park, Great North Road, Arkendale HG5 0FF (this is on the course - just south of Arkendale road end on A168) approx 1 mile to the Start - turn right from $\mathbf{H Q}$ car park onto A168, follow road 1 mile then $2^{\text {nd }}$ right into Limebar Lane. The finish is beyond this turn off.
All riders please be aware of earlier riders on the course when turning in and out of the HQ area and near the start as riders will be going in the same direction to FINISH beyond the turn to the start.

START on South side of Limebar Lane (road leading from Grafton to join A168, approx 2 miles South of Boroughbridge) at two way sign 10 yards East of A168 junction. PROCEED West to junction with A168, where Left and South on A168 to Walshford roundabout ( 5.992 miles).
take $3^{\text {rd }}$ exit (RIGHT) over fly over, over $\mathrm{Al}(\mathrm{M})$ to Bridge Hotel roundabout, Straight across ( $1^{\text {st }}$ exit) and continue South to slip road, signed Cowthorpe (Cowthorpe Lane). ( 7.224 miles.) Bear LEFT onto slip-road under fly-over, to T junction (Give Way and Turn Left with care) over fly-over to Turn Left down slip-road to join (WITH CARE) A168 Northbound (Give Way) ( 7.669 mls ).
Continue North, via Bridge Hotel roundabout where straight across ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ exit), to Walshford roundabout. $(8.970 \mathrm{mls})$. TURN LEFT ( $1^{\text {st }}$ exit) and continue northwards on A168 to FINISH at Field Gateway 100 yards North of two-way Traffic sign on Left, just North of Limebar Lane (15.00) miles.

Signing on sheet and numbers will be at the Business Park, in the courtyard, there are toilets but the café is shut on Sundays.
Please return number after your ride and SIGN OUT.
The Results board will be in the Courtyard and there will be cake etc available.
