Directions HQ to Start

The start is on the SW edge of Twyford on the B6047 at the bottom of thimble hill by a field gate opposite the last house. This will be signposted. The start from the village hall is 400 yards either right up King street or left via the main B6047.

Course Directions

Course GPX route can be downloaded from the CTT website.

The route is a mix of rolling quiet country lanes with many blind corners. Please ride on the LEFT hand side of the road and be prepared to stop at junctions to give way to traffic. Extreme CARE must be taken on the 3 right turns.

Start by gate @ bottom of Thimble Hill South West side of Twyford B6047. Up hill 3/4 mile turn right with CARE at top junction towards Queniborough, continue 1 miles and left into Baggrave park. CARE undulating road with cattlegrids. Exit via lodge, right turn, CARE at junction. Continue 1 mile and past Hungerton Black Boy pub then take left turn to Keyham. Left at junction onto Keyham lane, continue to T junction at Billesdon Coplow. Left turn and continue on top road towards Tilton-on-the-Hill. At T junction turn left and continue through Tilton village, turn right in filter lane at east end signed Halsted. Continue 100 yards then turn left onto Oakam Road. Continue 4 miles towards Braunston in Rutland. Sharp left at junction signpost Knossington. Continue 1.5 miles, to Knossington village left turn at T junction. Continue on main street by Fox and Hounds pub, CARE narrow road with parked cars. Continue 1.5 miles towards Somerby, then left at T junction. Continue 2 miles through Somerby and Pickwell. 500yards after Pickwell village fast left turn down hill to Little Dalby. Care on bends through woodlands. In 1 mile turn left at wooden bus shelter in Little Dalby. Continue 2 miles to Great Dalby. Left at junction uphill, follow road right at top of hill into village. At Junction with B6047 turn left towards Twyford. Continue 2.5 miles South through Thorpe Satchville on B6047 to Finish at bottom of hill at end of Layby. 27.2 miles Total.

Finish to HQ

After Finish continue South on B6047 to Twyford Village approx 1 mile. In Village left to village hall.
