


Safety information

- This race is promoted for and on behalf of Cycling Time Trials under its <u>rules and</u> <u>regulations</u>.
- This event will be run in accordance with CTT's current <u>Covid-19 Risk Assessment</u>. If
 you or any of your household are not well or are **SHOWING SIGNS OF COVID-19** or
 have tested positive and are currently isolating, please do not attend the event.
- Please take **EXTREME CARE** on the course as it is an open road that is narrow in places. The race will be well signed and marshalled but there may be cars on the course. The farm on the course has been notified of the event.
- Riders must **WEAR A HELMET** that conforms to a recognised standard.
- **FRONT AND REAR LIGHTS** must be affixed to the machine in a position where it is clearly visible to other road users.

At the HQ

- Competitors must SIGN IN before the race and SIGN OUT afterwards. Under 18s must bring a <u>parental consent form</u> when they sign in. Please use the toilet facilities at the theatre (HQ).
- There is on-street parking on London Road outside the theatre. PLEASE PARK
 CONSIDERATELY AND AVOID RESIDENTIAL AREAS. Please do not park in the
 residential roads opposite the theatre, in the centre of Holybourne village, or on the
 course itself.
- Residential properties back onto the HQ please keep **NOISE** to a minimum and be courteous to local residents when riding through the village and in the start area.
- Please do not wear **SHOE CLEATS** in the HQ.
- Noisy TURBO TRAINERS are not to be used within 100 yards of residential properties.
- Please join us at the HQ after the race for RESULTS, PRIZE GIVING AND
 REFRESHMENTS. Results will be emailed to competitors after the event.


Course description (HHC018)
