

### Course description

Start at the boundary point of Morley/Batley at the foot of the steep hill on Scotchman Lane (B6123). Proceed easterly up Scotchman Lane past the Needless Inn and on to the finish point at the west end of the M62 motorway bridge, after approximately 1km.

### Safety

---

In the interests of your own safety, CTT and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet which meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

**A hard shell helmet is compulsory for riders aged under 18 years and all Juniors & Juveniles.**

CTT recommends that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users, and is active whilst the machine is in use.
