0.00 miles	Start on Bomish Lane (Badger Bank to Goostrey) at telegraph pole No2 approx 300 yards west of the A535.
	Proceed east to the A535, turn left onto the A535 to
2.169 miles	Chelford Island, take the second exit left on the A537 and proceed to
5.219 miles	Ollerton Crossroads, where turn left into Seven Sisters Lane and proceed to the T junction with the A50 where turn left onto the A50 and proceed to
11.408 miles	Twemlow Lane at Cranage where turn left into Twemlow Lane and proceed to the junction with the A535 at Twemlow Green where turn left onto the A535 and proceed to
18.064 miles	Chelford Island, take the second exit left on the A537 and proceed to Ollerton Cross Roads, where turn left into Seven Sisters Lane and proceed to the T junction with the A50 where turn left onto the A50 and proceed to
25.000 miles	Finish at a J2/9 mark opposite the northern gate post of a field gate almost opposite the entrance to Mount Pleasant Nursing Home, approx 500 yards past the cross-roads after the Drovers Arms public house.

- Do not leave any clothing, bottles etc at the start.
- Vehicle parking is provided at Goostrey Village Hall.
- Changing facilities are available at the Goostrey Village Hall.
- The results board and refreshments will be available at Goostrey Village Hall.

NOTES AND LOCAL REGULATIONS

The Risk Assessment document will be available at Signing-On but we highly recommend you read this, in advance, on the CTT District website (<u>https://manchester.ctt.org.uk/</u>) – especially those riders who are not familiar with the course and its junctions (plus its ruts and potholes).

CARE AT ROAD JUNCTIONS

Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

CHELFORD ISLAND

Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Regulation 20, and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders MUST NOT USE their tri-bars between the first bollard they pass on entering the island and the last bollard they pass leaving it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.

SAFE RIDING

Riding with your head down such that you do not have a good view of the road ahead is dangerous - please watch out for potholes, obstacles, and other road users.

Marshalls do not have the authority to control other road users, so please take care.

START AND FINISH

No "U" turns in the vicinity of the start or finish. Riders must not stop at the finish but should instead continue back to the headquarters.

VEHICLES

A competitor must not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in any way receive assistance from a motorised vehicle or its occupants during events shorter than 100km (CTT Regulation 22). No parking for riders or spectators at the start or finish. This is both for the safety of riders at the start, and because of limited space.

Parking is available at the headquarters, please be considerate towards local residents.

OTHER NOTES

Road bike category:

The follow requirements are for the purposes of the road bike prize eligibility only -Road bikes will be checked at the start for compliance -

- The bike can possess drop or straight handlebars.
- No tri-bars, clip-on bars or Spinacci bars are allowed.
- No disc wheels.
- Both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each.
- The maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm.


A competitor overtaking another must pass without receiving or giving shelter. The onus of avoiding company riding shall be upon the rider overtaken. (CTT Regulation 21).

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY HELMETS - CTT Regulation 15

All competitors MUST wear a properly affixed helmet of hard/soft shell construction that meets international standards.

FRONT AND REAR LIGHT - CTT Regulation 14(j)

No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, and to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, each of which shall be either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.
