EVENT HEADQUARTERS:

Farndon Memorial Hall, Marsh Lane, Farndon, Newark, Notts. NG24 4TA which will be open from 7.00am.

PARKING:

There is limited parking at the event headquarters. However, there is plenty of parking in the lay-bys on Fosse Road.

DO NOT PARK UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES IN MARSH LANE. RIDERS MAY BRIEFLY PARK TO PICK UP THEIR NUMBERS.

NUMBERS:

Numbers will be situated in the headquarters and will be issued at signing-on. Please remember that riders must also sign out after the event. Failure to do so will result in a DNF.

REFRESHMENTS:

Refreshments will be available.

ROUTE TO START:

From HQ: Left out of HQ to t junction., where left on to Long Lane. Continue to T junction where right onto Fosse Road. Start approx. 2. 5 miles.

COURSE DETAILS: A25/34.

Start 36 yards after speed derestriction sign on southbound exit from East Stoke on Fosse Road. Proceed south to turn left at traffic island (near Eden Hall) to pass over A46 and turn left onto A46 southbound slip road. On A46 proceed south to take slip road from A46 to traffic roundabout at Stragglethorpe junction. Take 4th exit, pass under A46 to second roundabout. (Approx 10.36 miles). Take 3rd exit to slip road onto A46 northbound and proceed towards Newark. At Farndon roundabout take first exit onto Fosse Road (Approx 23.12miles) Proceed south on Fosse Road to finish at start of fence on RHS at gateway to River Trent and just before Stoke Warren Farm on approach to East Stoke (25.00 miles).

AFTER FINISHING:

After finishing retrace route towards Farndon where left into Long Lane, right into Marsh Lane. HQ on right.

DOPING CONTROL.

It is the rider's responsibility to make themselves available should UKAD be in attendance unless there are exceptional circumstances.

COVID 19 REGULATIONS.

Although Covid 19 restrictions have eased if you have Covid 19 or are feeling unwell **DO NOT ATTEND THIS EVENT.**

REGULATION 14. Competitor's Machine

- (i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.
- (j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 15. Protective Helmets

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078

ROAD BIKE CRITERIA

- No tri bars, clip on bars or Spinaci bars
- No disc wheels. Both front and rear wheels must have a minimum of 12 spokes each. The maximum rim depth on all wheels is 65mm
 - No aero helmet or a helmet that covers the ears or a helmet with a visor is to be used
 - Riders must not ride with their forearms resting on the handlebars at any time

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

NUMBERS: CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITION 2(i)

Competitors must only use the numbers supplied by the event organiser. Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16. Arm numbers should be fitted to the upper arms facing forwards.

USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

This event is under 100km. Riders should not be preceded, accompanied, followed by or in anyway receive assistance from a motorised vehicle.

REGULATION 14(i)

(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 14(j)

(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

REGULATION 15

All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.

REGULATION 17: SIGNING-ON SHEET AND SIGNING-OUT SHEET

- (a)The competitors in all types of events must make themselves aware of any special safety instructions for the event and sign the official Signing-on Sheet when collecting their number.
- (b)In Type A events a competitor must return to the event HQ either during the event or within a reasonable time after the last rider has finished the event and must (i) return their race number(s) and (ii) sign the official Signing-out Sheet. A rider who fails to so sign the official signing-out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.
- N.B. Extenuating circumstances may be considered.

THIS EVENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO A DOPING CONTROL

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control. Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ adjacent to the result board. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby. Remember, it is upto you to check and ensure that you comply. If required you must report to Doping Control after finishing without delay
