No competitor will be permitted to start unless they have a red rear light and a white front light both of which may be flashing or constant.

- All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet as detailed in regulation 15 in the CTT Handbook.
- Avoid making U-turns near the start and finish areas.
- To avoid congestion at the start please queue in single file.
- The race takes place on a public highway and the road is open to live traffic so you must always obey the Highway Code and must not impede other road users.
- Marshals are there to indicate direction only; it is your responsibility to give way to other vehicles that have priority at any point on the route. Disruption to other road users should be kept to a minimum.
- PLEASE KEEP YOUR HEAD UP FOR A SAFE RIDE.

V235 Course details

START approx. 3.5 miles south of Boroughbridge, in entrance to A168 from old A1 (now a long layby) at a point approx. 1 yard before Clearway"
TURN LEFT on to A168, and proceed south to Walshford Traffic Island (4.72 mls).
ENCIRCLE ISLAND and retrace north along A168, past start, to Boroughbridge South Traffic Island (12.27 mls)
ENCIRCLE ISLAND and retrace south on A168 to Walshford TI (2nd time) (19.86 mls).
ENCIRCLE ISLAND and proceed north on A168,
FINISH at northern end of crash barrier protecting road direction sign, on west side of road,
approx. 150yds south of Arkendale Road(Marton Lane) (25 miles).

HEADQUARTERS and PARKING -

is at The Courtyard Café,

Rabbit Hill Business Park, Great North Road, Arkendale, Knaresborough HG5 0FF

Rabbit Hill is on east side of A168, about 1 mile north of Allerton Park Waste Disposal Plant. On entering site, parking is on your right, Café is to your left. Numbers and signing-on/signing-out will be located here (outdoors). There are toilets available, but no changing facilities. Although Covid-19 requirements have eased, please be aware that some riders/helpers may wish to continue to follow previous rules – face coverings/distancing etc, own pens/pins, so do allow them sufficient space.

Please do not gather in groups at the start or obstruct the carriageway – cars/customers entering or leaving the site.

Do not park in the long-lay on the east side of the A168, adjacent to the start, it is now private property. There are other laybys/parking spaces on the A168, but the lay-by on west side of road, south of the A59 flyover is currently closed in connection with the works on the motorway.

<u>There is no parking available near the start, or at the finish, except for Officials</u>. The A168 is a Clearway – NO PARKING – NO U-TURNS.
