Parking is limited at the village hall. Then use ONLY the East side of the road, South of the Village Hall with all the wheels off the road. Please ensure that your vehicle is OFF the road - it might be YOU that gets baulked on the initial circuit.

Thank you in advance for not wearing cycling shoes or CLEATS in the Village hall.

# After the event, please remember to return to the HQ with your number to sign out after your ride. You can exchange your number for a FREE drink.

# 10 Miles Event – HQ to start 0.04 miles, and 0.46 miles from the finish 25 Miles Event – HQ to start 0.04 miles, and 0.38 miles from the finish.

#### Please note the following CTT regulations and recommendations

**Helmets**: CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

**Competitors' Machines**: It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

**Competitors' Vehicles**: No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish (District regulation).

**Safety Instructions**:Details of any additional hazards not listed on the start sheet will be displayed at the signing on point.

Warming Up: Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the event has started.

**Observers**: Official observers will be stationed around the course to ensure correct procedure (e.g. drafting and safety at roundabouts).

Results: No times will be given out at the finish line.

**Race Numbers**: The race number is made of fluorescent material which is an important safety feature. It is essential that it is placed correctly for maximum visibility to other road users and of course the timekeepers.

Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and Arm Numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forwards (not inwards).

HFRF

Be aware that "No time may be recorded if the number is incorrectly positioned".

#### Additional Safety Instructions

The location of Oakwood Hill Village Hall relative to the course means that there is nowhere off the course for warming up. Competitors are therefore requested to use one of the following options:-

- Turn LEFT out of the hall and ride down Honeywood Lane to the junction with Horsham Road. LEFT into Horsham Road down to Rowhook. Return to the hall by the same route, taking care not to onstruct Competitors alrrady racing.
- Follow route as above but continue through Rowhook to A29; LEFT on A29 to Ruckmans Lane; LEFT up Ruckmans
  Lane to junction with Honeywood Lane; LEFT to return to hall (this circuit is approximately 6.5 miles).

Competitors must exercise extra care when passing the start area and when joining the A29.


When crossing Honeywood Lane to reach the start Competitors MUST take care not impede earlier Competitors racing up Honeywood Lane.

After finishing Competitors should go straight on past the Start to Oakwood Hill Village Hall, taking care not to obstruct any Competitors still racing in Honeywood Lane.



CTT Regulations require the use of a helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards for all competitors.

CTT Regulations now require that no competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, and to the front of their machine, a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that are illuminated and positioned to be clearly visible to other road users.

London South DC strongly recommend that riders do not wear black or dark clothing during any event held on the public road.

Under 18 years old riders: Bring a completed parental consent form to present before signing-on. No form = no ride.


