COURSE DETAILS E9/25

START (GR 677076) on A1060 at western edge of drain adjacent to T.P.260 which is 210 yards west of Lordship Road (approximately 2.5 miles west of Chelmsford). Proceed along A1060 through Margaret Roding to Leaden Roding (M)(6.85m). Turn right WITH GREAT CARE onto B184 and continue through High Roding to turn around island at Clopton Hall Lane (M)(12.6m). Retrace through High Roding and Leaden Roding (M)(18.35m), turn along A1060 through Margaret Roding to FINISH (GR 675076) at a drain which is opposite the entrance to "Valley Way" bungalow. Parking must not be on A1060 but in old road opposite and 0.5 m before finish.

PLEASE NOTE : Regulation for Leaden Roding RAB

Any rider passing to the right of the painted circle at Leaden Roding mini roundabout will be disqualified from the event and reported to the District Secretary for consideration of disciplinary action.

ADDITIONAL NOTES TO RIDERS The following local regulations must be adhered to: -

- 1) No riding with your head down, any rider observed riding dangerously will be disqualified from the event and reported to the CTT District Committee for further disciplinary action. Have a fast, but safe ride.
- 2) NO 'U' TURNS are allowed within sight of either the start or finish area. Riders carrying out this dangerous maneuver are liable for disqualification from the event & further disciplinary action by the CTT District Committee.
- 3) Numbers and sign-on / sign-out will be situated in the HQ.
- 4) NO cars to stop or park at the start or finish areas. Warming-up by competitors is NOT allowed along any part of the designated course, after the event has started.
- 5) **Static trainers are banned from morning events in London East district. So please warm up on local roads.**
- 6) Riders waiting at start MUST stand on the grass verge.
- 7) Riders to take care through Leaden Roding and High Roding villages, beware parked cars **and** domestic driveway exits.

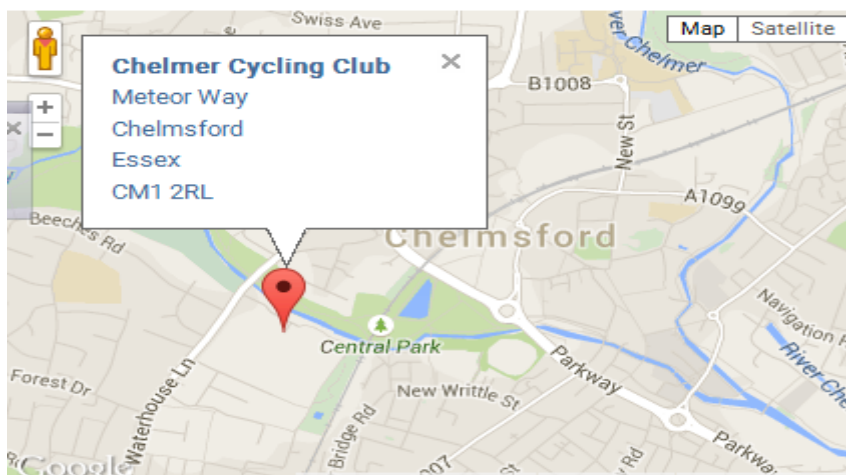
Lights and helmets: Working (White) front and (Red) rear lights are now **compulsory**, as is wearing a suitable cycling helmet. Without complying with these requirements, riders cannot start.

You and your bike WILL be checked at the start!!

HQ Location: There is (paid) parking in the Council car park at the entrance to Meteor Way on right as you enter Meteor Way.

Numbers, Signing in and signing out

You sign on in advance of your start at the HQ where you can collect your number and receive any last minute instructions or warnings. You will also need to sign out of the event otherwise you will be DISQUALIFIED.



Please allow at least 10 mins to ride from HQ to the Start Area.

Please avoid entering / warming up on the course!

There are ample roads to warm-up on the way to the start.

The HQ:

Toilet facilities are available in the Club Hut. Please use these, and all facilities respectfully of others.

To get the Start : Exit Meteor Way and turn right up the main road. Through first main lights and immediately bear left along A1060 (posted Leaden Roding, Sawbridgeworth). Keep following A1060, to pass over Writtle Roundabout. The start area is just ahead.

After the event : We have an independent caterer offering post-event cakes and nibbles. PLEASE support us as we start to get back to something like “normal” after Covid restrictions.

Road Bike Competition Regulations:

- No aerobars / clip-ons or extensions
- No Hands off the handlebars riding (with forearms resting in an aero position) – i.e. No "puppy paws" position.
- Wheels - min 12 spoke and maximum rim depth of 90mm
- No Visor integrated helmets
- Ears **MUST NOT** be covered by your helmet

BUT:

Skinsuits and overshoes **are** permitted.

So basically - If you look like you should in a Le Tour Road Stage, that should be fine!

There will be both Marshals and Observers out on the course checking – please ride safely!
