Medway Velo Club - Open 10 Mile Time Trial

Start on A.228 west of Grain village 14 metres north of the lamppost GFY26 on the Strood bound carriageway, by a minor access road to the National Grid site, where the continuous white road edge line starts. Proceed west on A228 to turn at Fenn Corner roundabout (5.07 miles). (M) Retrace on A.228 to finish directly opposite the lamppost GFY19 situated on Strood bound carriageway. (10 miles)



COMPETITORS NOTES

- 1. Please note that following an amendment to Regulation 14 at the CTT National Council AGM in December 2021 it is now compulsory for each rider to have a working white front and red rear light, steady or flashing, on their machine when they start in all CTT events.
- 2. Following an amendment to Regulation 15 at the CTT National Council AGM in December **2021 it is now compulsory** for ALL riders to wear recognised standard **protective headgear** that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
- Failure to have a working front & rear light and to be wearing recognised standard protective headgear on the start line will result in you not being allowed to start the event.
- 4. The event HQ is about 3 miles from the start. Allow plenty of time to get to the start and be aware of other competitors on the course.
- 5. Riders should not warm-up on the course after the start.
- 6. It would be appreciated if riders do not wear shoe plates inside the HQ.
- 7. There will be a pusher off available to all competitors, but please politely decline should you not wish to be pushed off.
- 8. Numbers should be centrally positioned below the waist, so as to be clearly visible from the rear. If the timekeepers cannot see your number, you may not be given a time.
- 9. After finishing, you must return your number and 'sign out'. This is for your own safety and failure to sign out may result in disqualification
- 10. Do Not perform U turns in the start and finishing areas and do not use these areas as a public toilet. Offenders will be disqualified.
- 11. Riders must abide by all traffic signs, any rider found crossing the pedestrian crossing on the course whilst the red light is showing will be disqualified
- 12. Riding with hands and wrists draped over the front of handlebars risks disqualification in line with regulation 20.

Accidents

If a competitor or official is involved in an accident/incident during or in the vicinity of the event, details must be reported as soon as practicable to the Event Secretary who will complete an Accident Report Form. Please assist/cooperate to ensure all required information is captured.

Road bike category rules:

- No aero bars
- No disc wheels / wheels deeper than 50mm
- No 'time trial' helmets or helmets designed to have visors
- Please indicate when signing on if you are competing in the road bike category.

COVID 19 Guidance – please read carefully

Competitors should not attend if they feel ill in ANY way.

- An elevated resting heart rate or exceptionally quick to react heart rate during warm up can suggest an underlying asymptomatic illness of ANY kind. You should NOT start the event (DNS) and leave immediately. Do not go to the start line if you feel this is the case and notify the organiser of your intention not to start as a result of an adverse warmup.
- Warm-ups ideally, should be done on the road. Static warm-ups are prohibited within 50 metres of any inhabited property, or in any location where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- It is strongly advised that all competitors carry a mobile phone and take with them the
 telephone number of the event organiser. Please telephone / text / WhatsApp the organiser if
 you have failed to finish the event.

If possible, please bring a pen to sign in / out. Hand sanitiser will be provided for use of riders before signing in / out.


There is some parking available at the HQ. There is alternative parking, close to the start/finish area, on Power Station Road.

Exit the hall turning right onto Cuckholds Green Rd, continuing onto Grain Rd, and turning left at the end of the road onto the A228. Continue for approximately 3 miles. The start area is on this road, located near to the National Grid site 'Gate I'.
